Attorney General's Explanatory Statement of Referendum No. 65.

This measure would allow the legislature to continue the six mill levy on all property in the state for the support of the Montana University System. It authorizes the levy of a tax of six mills or less for each of the next ten years and all money raised from this tax must be used for the University of Montana, Missoula; Montana State University, Bozeman; Eastern Montana College, Billings; Montana Tech, Butte; Northern Montana College, Havre; and Western Montana College, Dillon. This tax has been imposed for this purpose for the last twenty years.

REFERENDUM NO. 65

AN ACT SUBMITTING TO THE ELECTORATE AT THE NOVEMBER 1968 GENERAL ELECTION THE QUESTION OF WHETHER OR NOT THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY SHALL LEVY A PROPERTY TAX, IN ADDITION TO ANY LEVY AUTHORIZED BY SECTION 9, ARTICLE XII OF THE MONTANA CONSTITUTION, OF NOT TO EXCEED SIX (6) MILLS ON THE TAXABLE VALUE OF ALL REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY EACH YEAR FOR TEN (10) YEARS BEGINNING WITH THE YEAR 1969 AND APPROPRIATE THE REVENUE FROM THAT LEVY FOR THE SUPPORT, MAINTENANCE AND IMPROVEMENT OF THE MONTANA UNIVERSITY SYSTEM.
