A LAW PROPOSED BY INITIATIVE PETITION

THIS INITIATIVE PROPOSES TO CHANGE THE MONTANA INCOME TAX STRUCTURE TO REQUIRE THAT TAX BRACKETS, EXEMPTIONS, STANDARD DEDUCTIONS, AND MINIMUM FILING REQUIREMENTS BE ADJUSTED EACH YEAR TO PREVENT TAX INCREASES DUE SOLELY TO INFLATION. IF THIS INITIATIVE IS ENACTED IT WILL BE EFFECTIVE IN 1981.

INITIATIVE NO. 87

A LAW PROPOSED BY INITIATIVE PETITION

THIS INITIATIVE:

- PROVIDES THAT A VOLUNTARY PROGRAM TO RECYCLE BEVERAGE CONTAINERS MAY BE ESTABLISHED BY BEVERAGE AND RECYCLING BUSINESSES;
- PLACES A MINIMUM 5¢ REFUNDABLE DEPOSIT ON ALL BEVERAGE CONTAINERS IF THE VOLUNTARY RECYCLING PROGRAM FAILS TO RECYCLE 60% OF ALL BEVERAGE CONTAINERS BY 1982, 75% BY 1983, AND 85% AFTER 1983;
- PROHIBITS THE SALE OF ANY NON-REFILLABLE GLASS OR PLASTIC BEVERAGE BOTTLES AND NON-RECYCLABLE BEVERAGE CANS AFTER MARCH, 1983, AND THE SALE OF DETACHABLE PULL-TABS AND USE OF PLASTIC CONNECTORS AFTER MARCH, 1982;
- ALLOWS PRIVATE RECYCLING CENTERS TO REDEEM AND RECYCLE BEVERAGE CONTAINERS.
