PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO BELGRADE CITY CHARTER: Article II, Section 2.01 (4) states City Councilpersons and the City Mayor are to serve in their elective offices without salary or financial consideration. Ordinance 96-5 has been passed amending the charter and establishing a monthly salary of \$125 per month or the sum of \$67.50 for each regularly scheduled meeting attended by Councilpersons and \$200 per month or the sum of \$100 for each regularly scheduled meeting attended by the Mayor. A vote for Ordinance 96-5 will amend the charter to allow salaries for Councilpersons and Mayor. A vote against Ordinance 96-5 will leave the charter as it presently exists.
