GENERAL DISTRICT BALLOT
SOURDOUGH RURAL FIRE
DISTRICT NO. 155

May 2, 2000

Shall the Sourdough Rural Fire District trustees and the Gallatin County Commission be authorized to approve increases in the annual tax levy of property in the Fire District of up to, but not to exceed, 48.40 mills or \$296,119.00, whichever is greater (but not including property which is "newly taxable property" after December 31, 1999) for the essential services provided by the Fire District.

This authorization to approve an increase would be 229,119.00 above the I-105 and SB-184 property tax limitations. The authorized increase would be in effect for all future tax levies, until changed by law.

This authorization for increasing taxing authority will not affect taxation by any other governmental agency and is only for the Sourdough Rural Fire District.

RAE SUBDIVISION COUNTY WATER &
SEWER DISTRICT NO. 313

SHOULD the Rae Water and Sewer District incur a bonded indebtedness for the benefit of all lands within the District by the issuance of up to Two Hundred Thousand and no/100 Dollars (\$200,000.00) in revenue bonds for the purpose of financing a portion of the District's share of the cost of the renovation and improvements to the District's wastewater system with the term of the bonds being not more than 20 years.
