**GENERAL OBLIGATION BOND ELECTION**

Shall the Commission be authorized to issue and sell general obligation bonds of the City in the amount of Four Million and No/100 Dollars (\$4,000,000), bearing interest at a rate to be determined by the Commission after a competitive sale, payable semiannually during a term of not to exceed twenty (20) years and redeemable on any interest payment date after one-half of their term, for the purpose of acquiring land for the designing, constructing and equipping either a new public library or designing, constructing and equipping an expansion of the existing library, and paying costs associated with the sale and issuance of the bonds?
