BALLOT ISSUE

Should the qualified voters of the City of Three Forks authorize the City Council of Three Forks to levy three additional mills for the continued operation of the Three Forks Library. The specific amount to be raised is \$5,052.00 and the specific purpose for which the additional money will be used is for wages and insurance benefits for a full-time librarian. The approximate amount of mills required is 3 additional mills, allowing a total of 6.28 mills for library operating. The duration of the levy is indefinite.

The statement of impact of the election on a home valued at \$100,000 and a home valued at \$200,000 in terms of actual dollars in additional property taxes that would be imposed on residences with those values if the mill levy were to pass is \$10.63 for a home appraised in 1997 at \$100,000 and \$21.26 for a home appraised in 1997 at \$200,000.
