Shall the Board of Directors of Big Sky County Water & Sewer District No. 363, Montana (the "District") b authorized to sell general obligation bonds of the District in an amount not to exceed Thirteen Million Five Hundred and No/100 Dollars (\$13,500,000), payable over a term of twenty (20) years, for the purpose of paying the costs of financing, designing, constructing and installing a wastewater treatment plant, wastewater force main, pumping station(s) and related improvements, and appurtenances to the District wastewater system (the "Project"), and to pay costs associated with the sale and issuance of the Bonds? The Project will benefit all properties in the Sewer System Jurisdictional Area, the boundaries of which are on file in the office of the District and the office of the Gallatin County Clerk and Recorder.
