Shall the Board of Directors of Big Sky County Water & Sewer District No. 363, Montana (the "District") be authorized to sell general obligation bonds of the District in an amount not to exceed Thirteen Million Five Hundred and No/100 Dollars (\$13,500,000), payable over a term of twenty (20) years, for the purpose of paying the costs of financing, designing, constructing and installing a wastewater treatment plant, wastewater force main, pumping station(s) and related improvements, and appurtenances to the District wastewater system (the "Project"), and to pay costs associated with the sale and issuance of the Bonds? The Project will benefit all properties in the Sewer System Jurisdictional Area, the boundaries of which are on file in the office of the District and the office of the Gallatin County Clerk and Recorder. The Bonds will bear interest at a rate not to exceed 4% per annum and be payable from an ad valorem property tax levied against all properties in the Sewer System Jurisdictional Area and other available revenues of the Sewer System and Sewer System Jurisdictional Area, except that all property in the Sewer System Jurisdictional Area currently owned by Westland Enterprises, Inc. and TM Land Partners Limited consisting of lands located in Section 31, Township 6 South, Range 4 East, and Section 1, Township 7 South, Range 3 East, as more specifically described in the Gallatin County Clerk and Recorder's office (the "Westland Property") will not be taxed to pay principal of and interest on the Bonds pursuant to an order of the Supreme Court dated June 2, 1989.

Shall the Board of Directors of Big Sky County Water & Sewer District No. 363, Montana (the "District") be authorized to sell general obligation bonds of the District in an amount not to exceed Two Million Five Hundred Thousand and No/100 Dollars (\$2,500,000), payable over a term of twenty (20) years, for the purpose of paying the costs of designing, constructing and installing improvements to the Big Sky Public water system, consisting of water meters, a storage tank, booster station, water mains, related improvements (the "Project") and to pay costs associated with the sale and issuance of the Bonds? The Project will benefit all properties in the Water System Jurisdictional Area, the boundaries of which are on file in the office of the District and the office of the Gallatin County Clerk and Recorder. The Bonds will bear interest at a rate not to exceed 4% per annum and be payable from an ad valorem property tax levied against all properties in the Water System Jurisdictional Area and other available revenues of the Water System and Water System Jurisdictional Area.
