Shall the Board of Gallatin County Commissioners be authorized to issue and sell general obligation bonds in the amount of up to \$18,370,000 to be payable during a period of 20 years from the date of issuance for the purpose of funding the acquisition, design, construction, equipping, and financing of an adult detention facility on property owned by Gallatin County south of Oak Street, east of North 19th Avenue and west of North 7th Avenue, Bozeman, Montana?

Shall the Board of Gallatin County Commissioners be authorized to make a levy of up to 13 (Thirteen) Mills in addition to the mill levy imposed by law for the purpose of funding operations for a New Adult Detention Facility in Gallatin County?

The maximum amount of money that will be raised, based on Gallatin County Fiscal Year 2002 mill rate, is \$1,614,847.00 per year. The levy shall be in perpetuity, provided that the Gallatin County Commission may impose such levy no earlier than October 2004, and the Gallatin County Commission may determine in any future fiscal year that the number of mills levied should be less than 13 (Thirteen) Mills.

STATEMENT OF IMPACT: Based on the fiscal year 2002 County mill value, if this mill levy passes a maximum of \$45.00 of additional property taxes will be imposed on a home valued at \$100,000 and a maximum of \$90.00 of additional property taxes will be imposed on a home valued at \$200,000.

The bonds shall be payable from revenues received by the District, and to the extent those are insufficient, from an ad valorem property tax on all property in the District.
