Shall the Board of Directors of 4 Dot Meadows County Sewer District, Montana (the "District") be authorized to sell revenue bonds of the District in an amount not to exceed One Million Five Hundred Thousand and No/100 Dollars (\$1,500,000), payable over a period of not more than 20 years, for the purpose of paying the costs of acquiring the existing privately owned sewer system currently providing service to the District and paying the costs associated with the sale and issuance of the bonds (the "Project")? The total cost of the Project is estimated to be \$1,500,000 and will be paid from the proposed bonds. The bonds shall be payable from revenues received by the District, and to the extent those are insufficient, from an ad valorem property tax on all property in the District.
