Special Mail Ballot Election - Bozeman High School District 7

BOZEMAN HIGH SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 7

Shall the Board of Trustees of High School District No. 7 (Bozeman), Gallatin County, Montana, be authorized to issue and sell general obligation bonds of the District in the amount of Seventeen Million Two Hundred Ninety Thousand and No/100 Dollars (\$17,290,000), bearing interest at a rate to be approved by the Board at the time of the sale not to exceed 7.00% per annum, payable semiannually, during a term of not more than twenty (20) years, and redeemable on any date after one-half the term, for the purpose of paying the costs of renovating and remodeling the Bozeman High School, to include: installing mechanical and electrical upgrades; designing, constructing, installing and equipping additions or modifications to the central core, health enhancement areas, new ADA accessible classrooms and/or teacher work areas; replacing windows to provide energy efficiency; upgrading bathrooms to provide ADA accessibility; related improvements, furniture and equipment; and paying costs associated with the sale and issuance of the bonds (the "project")?
