Should the qualified voters of the Soudrough Rural Fire District authorize the Board of Trustees of the Soudrough Rural Fire District and the Galatia County Commission to approve an increase in the annual fee for fire protection to exceed 38 mills or 3.8% which would result in an increase in the annual fee for fire protection to 42.8 mills or 4.28% for the essential services provided by the District, the voters would be asked to vote for the property tax limitation of sections 15-10-401 and 402 (1999).

This increased voting authority will not be exercised by other governmental agencies and is only for fire protection purposes.
