The annual increase would be used for the annual payment of a new fire engine; the increase exceeds property tax limitations in Sections 15-10-401 and 15-10-402, M.C.A. (1999).

This increased taxing authority will not affect taxation by other governmental agencies and is only for Gallatin Gateway Rural Fire District purposes.
