The undersigned, your petitioners, citizens of the United States, respectfully show and represent that they are ~~residents~~ ^{residents} of Road District No. 6 in the County of Gallatin, in the State of Montana, and taxable therein for road purposes; ~~that they reside in the vicinity of the road hereinafter petitioned for;~~ that the proposed road will be a public convenience, and we think the public good requires it.

REPORT OF ROAD VIEWERS.

To the Honorable, the Board of County Commissioners of Gallatin County:

WE, the undersigned Road Viewers, appointed by the ^{Co. Surveyor} ~~Board of County Commissioners~~, at the ~~term of said Board~~ together with the ^{Co. Surveyor} ~~Board of County Commissioners~~, at the ~~term of said Board~~ to view a proposed road running from the N.E. Corner of Sec 33 T. 3 N. R. 5 E.

to the corner of section 7, 8, 17 & 18 T. 2 N. R. 5 E. say, That on the 23^d day of Aug, 1897, we started from the above described starting point the place designated in the petition as the starting point of such proposed road and

proceeded to view and lay out the same, and submit the following report: ^{W. H. Davis the viewor appointed by the chairman of the Board of Co. Commissioners did not appear, and we was unable to get a viewor to act in his place.}

1. The course, termini, length and probable cost of constructing the proposed road, as follows: From the above starting point, thence west along the sec. line between sections 28 & 33 T. 3 N. R. 5 E. to the east edge of the swamp thence along the old road around the north end of the swamp in Sec. 28 to said sec. line. Thence west to the 1/4 Sec. Cor. between sections 29 & 32 said T. & R. Thence crossing the N.W. Corner of the N.E. 1/4 of said Sec. 32 to the west line thence ^(See Back of Report)

2. The estimate of damages to the owner of any land over which it is proposed to run the highway, as follows: The owners of all lands over which the proposed road runs, are, ^{see field} fully equal to the amount of the damages

3. The names of land owners who consent to give the right of way, and we hereto attach their written consent, as follows: Louis Accola, A. J. Cowan, W. H. Collins, Southby & Hutchinson, Jesse Lambert, H. Biggs, G. Biggs, Conrad Stang, Thomas Cable

4. The names of land owners who do not consent and the amount of damages claimed by each, as follows: J. K. Green claims damages for fence & land in the amount of \$60.00 the bridge over mill creek to be sufficiently large to allow same to be used for a cattle pass.

5. The following facts bearing upon the subject, which may be of importance to the Board: From the starting point to the south 1/4 Sec. Cor. of Sec. 32 the fences have been set back giving the road, along or near the full length of the road there is indication of a good deal of travel. All of the settlers along the road ^(See Back of Report) We believe said road to be practicable and of public utility and necessity and do recommend the establishment of the same.


