The undersigned, your petitioners, citizens of the United States, respectfully show and represent that they are ~~freeholders~~ *residents* of Road District No. 6 in the County of Gallatin, in the State of Montana, and taxable therein for road purposes; that they reside in the vicinity of the road hereinafter petitioned for; that the proposed road will be a public convenience, and we think the public good requires it.

Your petitioners respectfully ask ~~your Honorable Body to lay out, locate and establish a County road~~ *that a County Road be* sixty feet wide, in said road district, to be a public highway therein, and show:

(a). The general route of the proposed road. (b). Over what lands it is proposed to be established. (c). Who are the owners thereof: (d). Whether such of them as can be found consent thereto. (e). Who of them do not consent. (f). The probable cost of the right of way where such consent is not had. (g). The necessity for and the advantages of the proposed road, as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at a point in the River Creek road, about 1/4 mile easterly from the residence of E. Cantel, said point being near the gate opening into E. Cantel's field, and designated on the map of said River Creek road as angle point No 54 see plot Book of Woods Vol. A. 272-185 thence north easterly to or near the north 1/4 sec. 16, T. 4 N. R. 5 E., thence north along or near the north and south 1/4 sec. in T. 4 N. R. 5 E. 33, 28, 21 and 16, T. 2 N. R. 5 E. to intersect with the Martin Road at or near the point where said N + S 1/4 sec line joins Sec 16 crosses said Martin Road.

The owners are as shown on accompanying sketch

The necessity for the proposed road is to provide an outlet for a large tract of country lying between the Morgan Road and the Martin Road.

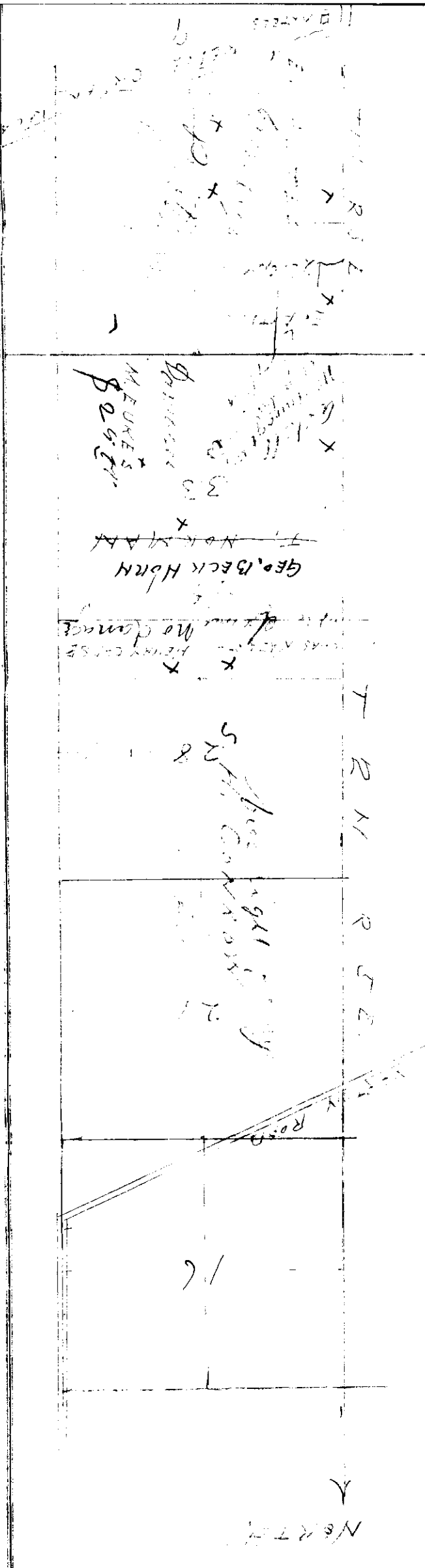

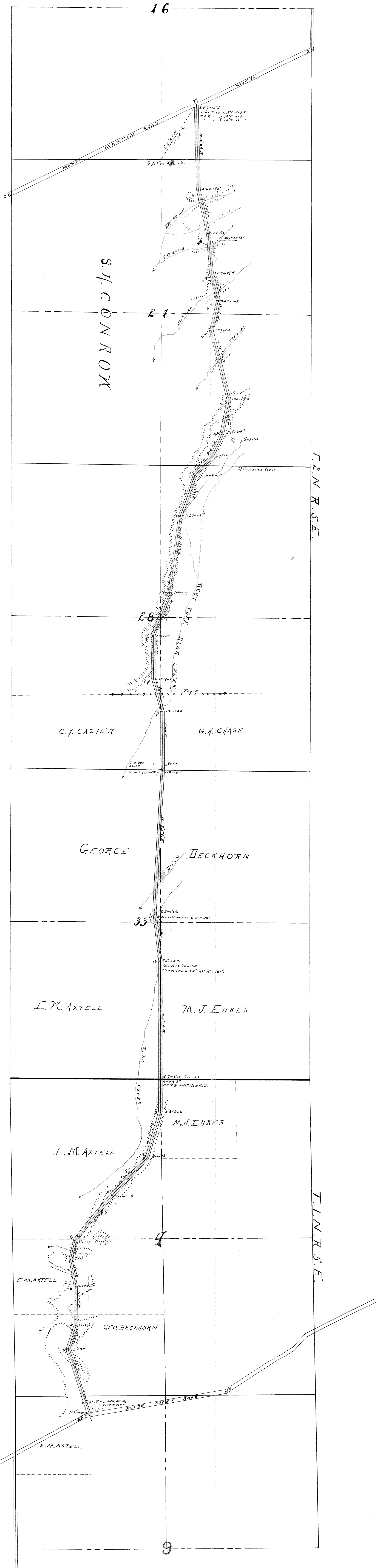
Map of Canyon Road
