crossing of the said R.R. track in the N.W. 1/4 of Sec. 36
T. 1 S. R. 5 E. thence N.W. 1/4 parallel with said track
and 84 feet therefrom to a point where said
center line would intersect the north line of said
Sec. 36. The fence along said proposed change
to be made by said County, including masonry repairs.
The County to pay for the growing crop at the
