PETITION FOR ROAD.

To the County Surveyor of Gallatin County, Montana:

The Undersigned, your petitioners, citizens of the United States, respectfully show and represent that they are residents of Road District No. 4, in the County of Gallatin, State of Montana, where the road hereafter petitioned for, is to be located, laid out and established, if this petition be granted. That the proposed ^{change of} road will be a public convenience, and, we think, the public good requires it. ^{the same}

Your petitioners do respectfully ask and petition that a County road, sixty feet in width, to be a public highway, be laid out, located and established, and show:— (a) The general route of the proposed road; (b) over what lands it is proposed to be established; (c) who are the owners thereof; (d) whether such of them as can be found, consent thereto; (e) who of them do not consent; (f) the probable cost of the right-of-way where such consent is not had; (g) the necessity for and the advantages of the proposed road as follows, to-wit:

(a) Beginning at a point in the county road along the west side of the west Gallatin river, said point being about 1/4 mile south of the north line of section 5 T. 4 S. R. 4 E. the same being south of the graded portion of said road at about that point. thence southerly along the west bank of said river as close to the same as practicable to a point near the dam at the head of the Klein Schmidt canal, at which point the proposed road intersects the old road a distance of about

(2, d, e, f, g) the proposed change is all on said Sec. 5 owned by A. Vieux who hereby agrees to do all work, (grading & bridge building) required to make the proposed change as good as the old road ^{without expense to the County.} The portion of the old road between the beginning & terminus of the above described change to be vacated and discontinued whenever the proposed change shall be granted. Said old road not to be closed until the proposed change shall be made as good as said old road, and the work on said change accepted by the ^{County Commissioners} Surveyor. The object of the proposed change is to avoid cutting up the land in said Sec. 5 and to save fencing.
