# PETITION FOR ROAD.

To the County ~~Commissioner~~ <sup>Surveyor</sup> of Gallatin County, Montana:

The Undersigned, your petitioners, citizens of the United States, respectfully show and represent that they are residents of Road District No. <sup>4</sup>, in the County of Gallatin, State of Montana, where the road hereafter petitioned for, is to be located, laid out and established, if this petition be granted. That the proposed road will be a public convenience, and, we think, the public good requires it.

Your petitioners do respectfully ask and petition that a County road, sixty feet in width, to be a public highway, be laid out, located and established, and show:— (a) The general route of the proposed road; (b) over what lands it is proposed to be established; (c) who are the owners thereof; (d) whether such of them as can be found, consent thereto, (e) who of them do not consent; (f) the probable cost of the right of way where such consent is not had; (g) the necessity for and the advantages of the proposed road as follows, to-wit:

To change road now running diagonally through S. P. Looney's land in West half of Sec. 30, T. 2, S. R. 4 East, and through N.E. 1/4 of Sec. 25 + 25, 1832, as follows: Commencing in said road at Southwest corner of North West quarter of South East quarter of said Sec. 30, thence running North one-half mile, thence West one-half mile, thence North one quarter of a mile to N. W. Corner of said Sec. 30. — thence West one-half mile, on North line of Sec 25, in T. 2, S. R. 4 East.

"Dave McLeod Road." — The owners of land where said road is proposed are Theodore Antonson, S. P. Looney, who are <sup>all the</sup> owners concerned. ~~and~~ all of said owners consent to said change in said Road. — The necessity for & advantages of said change are, that it will conform to legal subdivision lines of said sections, instead of cutting the land diagonally of section lines, — and that it will give more citizens a frontage on said public Road, and is just as good Natural Road Bed. No work has been done on the Dave McLeod Road.

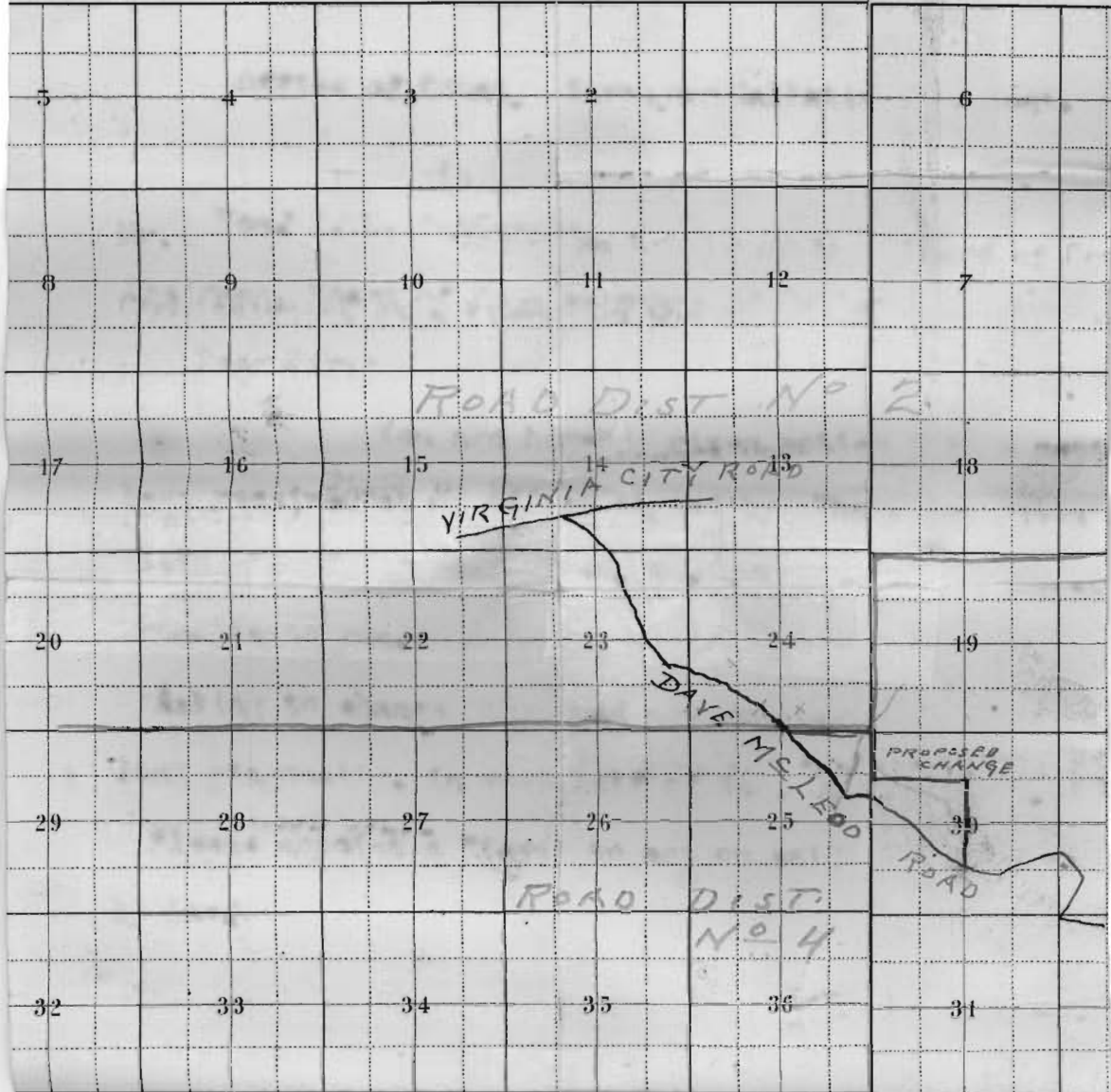

## REPORT OF ROAD VIEWERS.

ROAD NO. 162

TO THE HONORABLE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF GALLATIN COUNTY, MONTANA:

We, the undersigned Road Viewers, consisting of Matt. Nibel who was appointed by the chairman of the Board of County Commissioners C.M. Hope Es. Surveyor, and Geo. Gibson who was appointed by said Surveyor.

appointed to view a proposed <sup>change of</sup> road running from a point in the Savre McLeod Road when the same is crossed by the N+S. center line of Sec. 30 T2S R.4E. to a point in the north line of Sec. 25 T2S R.3E. where the same is crossed by said Savre McLeod. as described in the annexed petition, say, That on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of Aug.

A. D., 1899 we assembled at the place designated in the petition, as the starting point of such proposed <sup>change of</sup> road and proceeded to view the same, and submit the following report:

1. The width of the proposed <sup>change of</sup> road, the description of the center line of the same, the length, how defined, the marks and sources, grades, character of ground, description of the land and owners of the same, over which the proposed road passes, and probable cost of constructing the said road, as follows:

The width of the proposed <sup>change of</sup> road is 60 feet. The description of the center line of the 60 feet right of way is described as follows to-wit: Beginning at a point on the center line of the Savre McLeod Road as surveyed May 16 1895 where the same is intersected by the N+S. center line of Sec. 30 T2S R.4E. said point being 1660.6 feet north of the S. 1/4 Sec. cor. of said Sec. 30, thence north along said 1/4 Sec. line 869.2 feet. thence N. 85° 47' W. 2513.6 feet. to the west line of said Sec. 30 thence north along said sec. line 1062.9 feet. thence N. 48° 57' E. 236.2 feet thence N. 41° 15' W. 264.8 feet. to a point in the west line of said Sec. 30, thence north along said line 642.4 feet to a point 549 feet south of the N.
