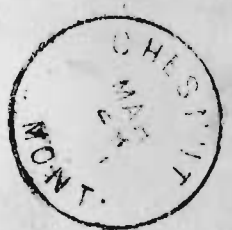

PETITION FOR ROAD.

Hon. Board of County Commissioners
 To the ~~County Surveyor~~ of Gallatin County, Montana:

The Undersigned, your petitioners, citizens of the United States, respectfully show and represent that they are residents of Road District No. 5, in the County of Gallatin, State of Montana, where the road hereafter petitioned for, is to be located, laid out and established, if this petition be granted. That the proposed road will be a public convenience, and, we think, the public good requires it.

Your petitioners do respectfully ask and petition that a County road, sixty feet in width, to be a public highway, be laid out, located and established, and show:— (a) The general route of the proposed road; (b) over what lands it is proposed to be established; (c) who are the owners thereof; (d) whether such of them as can be found, consent thereto; (e) who of them do not consent; (f) the probable cost of the right-of-way where such consent is not had; (g) the necessity for and the advantages of the proposed road as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at angle point No. 53 of the survey of the county road from Bridger, to Timberline, as shown on page 131. Vol. "A" Plat Book of Roads of Gallatin County. the same being at the corner in said road East of O. Malmborg's house in the S.E. 1/4 of section 2, T. 2 S. R. 7 E.

thence in an easterly direction along the north side of O. Malmborg's irrigating ditch, to the canyon known as Jackson's canyon, thence up said canyon by the most practical route, to the point where said canyon is crossed by the East line of section 1, T. 2 S. R. 7 E. the same being the line between Gallatin and Park counties. the proposed road will pass through the S.E. 1/4 of said sec. 2, T. 2 S. R. 7 E. and sec. 1 said T. & R. owned by O. Malmborg, who does not consent to give the right of way. the object of the proposed road is to open a road way to the timber in said canyon. this being the most practical place in this section of country to obtain fencing, mining timber, and lumber. the probable cost of the right of way for the proposed road will be. About Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00)

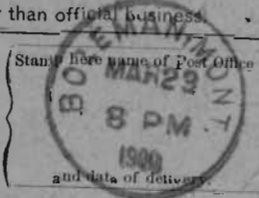
