PETITION FOR ROAD.

To the Board of County Commissioners
of Gallatin County, Montana:

The Undersigned, your petitioners, citizens of the United States, respectfully show and represent that they are residents of Road District No. 3, in the County of Gallatin, State of Montana, where the road hereafter petitioned for, is to be located, laid out and established, if this petition be granted. That the proposed road will be a public convenience, and, we think, the public good requires it.

Your petitioners do respectfully ask and petition that a County road, sixty feet in width, to be a public highway, be laid out, located and established, and show:— (a) The general route of the proposed road; (b) over what lands it is proposed to be established; (c) who are the owners thereof; (d) whether such of them as can be reached, consent thereto; (e) who of them do not consent; (f) the probable cost of the right-of-way where such consent is not had; (g) the necessity for and the advantages of the proposed road as follows, to-wit:

(a) Beginning at a point in the north line of Sec 15-
T. 2. N. R. 4. E. where the road to The Meadows mts
intersects said line. Thence run west about 100 yds
thence in a southerly direction following the bluff
on east side of ravine, which begins in N.W. 1/4
of Sec 15, to section line of 16 & 22. Thence east-
on said line to 1/2 mile corner, thence south 1/2 mile

You shall notify the resident owner or agent of land over which it passes, of the proposed route; ascertain whether such owner consents thereto and the amount of damages, if any, claimed or demanded for the right of way over the same. You shall estimate the actual damage to any land over which the proposed road passes and the cost of any bridges or grading necessary. You shall report the necessity for and the public convenience to be subserved by the highway, if opened, and whether the opening thereof or the change therein proposed should be made, and make and sign a report of your proceedings, as required by law.

Roads shall, in all cases, when practical, be laid out on subdivisional or section lines.

REPORT OF ROAD VIEWERS.

ROAD NO. 195

TO THE HONORABLE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF GALLATIN COUNTY, MONTANA:

We, the undersigned Road Viewers, consisting of G. W. Kinney, F. H. Gillet,
and C. M. Thorpe, appointed by J. L. Patterson chairman
of the Board of County Commissioners

appointed to view a proposed road running from the N¹/₄ Sec. Cor. of Sec. 15
T. 2 N. R. 4 E.
to the S.W. corner of Sec. 35 said T. & R.
as described in the annexed petition, say, That on the 15th day of June
A. D., 1900 we assembled at the place designated in the petition, as the starting point of such proposed
road and proceeded to view the same, and submit the following report:

1. The width of the proposed road, the description of the center line of the same, the length, how
defined, the marks and sources, grades, character of ground, description of the land and owners of the
same, over which the proposed road passes, and probable cost of constructing the said road, as follows:

The width of the proposed is 60 feet.
The description of the center line of the proposed
road is described as follows to wit: Beginning
at the North ¹/₄ Sec. Cor. of Sec. 15 T. 2 N. R. 4 E. thence
south along the N & S ¹/₄ Sec. line to the S ¹/₄ Sec. corner

the East ¹/₄ section corner of said Sec. 22, thence ^{thence East} south
along the section line between sections 22 and 23, ^{to Sec. Cor.}

and 27, said T. & R. nearly ¹/₄ mile, to top of bluff on N.W. side
of gulch, thence S. Ely. along top of bluff to a point in the south
line of the N. ¹/₂ of N.W. ¹/₄ of said Sec. 26. thence East along
said south line to the gulch near the N.E. Cor. of the S.W. ¹/₄ of N.W.
¹/₄ of said Sec. 26, thence S. Ely. along said gulch where
required to obtain a grade not exceeding 8% to the
Dry Creek Road. the corner being on the S.E. ¹/₄ of the N.W.
¹/₄ of said Sec. 26, thence S. Wly. along said Dry
Creek Road, to Miller and Tabor's corner. the corner being
known as the "Big Post." at the S.W. corner of said S.E. ¹/₄ of
N.W. ¹/₄ of Sec 26, thence south along the line ¹/₄ mile
East of the west line of said section 26 and 35 said T & R.
¹/₂ miles to the south line of said Sec. 35, intersecting
at said point with the County road running E & W. along
the south side of said Sec. thence west along said south
line ¹/₄ mile to the S.W. Cor. of said Sec. 35 the same
being the terminus as described in the petition

The portion of the Dry Creek Road running from the above described Tador and Miller's corner the same being the S.W. corner of the S.E. 1/4 of the N.W. 1/4 of said Section 26 southwesterly and south to the South 1/4 Section corner of Section 34 T. 2 N. R. 4 E. to be vacated and discontinued whenever the above described new road shall be established and the same opened for travel. We made the following changes from the line as petitioned for, in Sec. 15 the road was described as running from the starting point west thence south along top of bluff to south pier, thence East to 1/4 Sec. line. We have laid out the road along the 1/4 Sec. line making a straight road, the same being on better ground and shorter than the line as petitioned for. At N.E. cor. of S.E. 1/4 of Sec. 22 instead of running to the E. 1/4 Sec. corner as petitioned for we cross said N.E. cor. by so doing we obtain a grade not over 8% while on the line as petitioned for it would be 20%.

In the S.W. 1/4 of Sec. 35 instead of running west and south around the S.W. 1/4 of said S.W. 1/4 we laid out said road straight south through the center of said S.W. 1/4 thereby saving 1/2 mile for all who travel toward Bogerman and saving the road an extra grade with no expense for construction.

The length of the proposed road is nearly 5 miles. We marked out the line of the proposed road where the same does not follow section or subdivision lines by blazing fence posts and setting stakes.

A survey will be necessary to properly mark and define the line of the road. The grades of the proposed road will not exceed 8% when properly graded.

The ground over which the road passes is suitable for road building being hard and gravelly.

4. The estimate of damages in excess of benefits to the owner of any land over which it is proposed to run the highway, as follows:

We estimate that T. Murrelley is damaged in excess of benefits to the amount of fence material for 2 miles of fence, ^{and a cattle pass} and would recommend that the same be furnished him. Also that G.W. Shaw be allowed \$30.00 for extra right of way, (there by saving several times that amount of ^{expense for} grading). Also that W.T. Gadsen be allowed fence material for 5/8 miles of fence as he has an outlet. Also that F. + W. Ballard. be allowed fence material for 1/4 mile of fence + a cattle pass, for allowing road to run through their land, which will ^{save} several times the expense in construction.

5. The following facts, bearing upon the subject, which may be of importance to the Board:

The proposed road coincides with that portion of the road leading to the Hoover shoe mountains + Basin, as established last year. It also straightens and shortens the Dry Creek Road, making a change which has long been desired. We believe said road to be an important road and much needed, and have not been able to learn of any objection to the same.

We believe said road _____ to be practical and _____ of public utility and necessity and do _____ recommend the establishment of the same.
