REPORT OF ROAD VIEWERS.

We, the undersigned Road Viewers, consisting of Louis J. Anthony
C. M. C. Morrison and C. M. Thorpe
 who were appointed by J. D. Patterson chairman of

appointed to view a proposed road running from a point on the line between

1. The width of the proposed road, the description of the center line of the same, the length, how

 same, over which the proposed road passes, and probable cost of constructing the said road, as follows:
 The width of the proposed road is 60 feet.
 The description of the center line of the same is as
 follows to wit:— Beginning at a point in the ^{line} between
 section 1 and 12 T. 2 N. R. 7 E. where the same is crossed
 by the line between Gallatin and Park Counties the same
 being about 1/4 mile west of the S.E. corner of Sec.
 1 said T. & R. thence west along the ^{line} between said sections
 1 & 12 to a point about 600 feet west of the S.W. corner
 of said sections, thence N.W. by to head of small draw
 thence down the draw S.W. by to sec. line intersecting the

obliterated), where the road does not follow the
section line the same is defined by stakes
blazed from posts, and trees, the proposed road should be surveyed.

The steepest grade will be about 12%, as this is on
the eastern portion of the road which is designed principally
as a stock road, it will not be an objection to the road.

The ground over which the proposed road passes
is nearly all hard and suitable for road building
For description of land and names of owners along
the proposed road. see annexed sketch.

The probable cost of constructing the proposed
road is, for bridges and culverts, \$250.00
for grading 275.00
total cost. \$525.00

The above estimate only covers such work as may
be required to make the road safe & passible.
