PETITION FOR ROAD.

Hon. Board of County Commissioners
To the County Surveyor of Gallatin County, Montana:

The Undersigned, your petitioners, citizens of the United States, respectfully show and represent that they are residents of Road District No. 4, in the County of Gallatin, State of Montana, where the road hereafter petitioned for, is to be located, laid out and established, if this petition be granted. That the proposed road will be a public convenience, and, we think, the public good requires it.

Your petitioners do respectfully ask and petition that ^{AS DESCRIBED BELOW AS WIDENED TO 40 FEET WEST OF THE SECTION LINE,} County road ^{40 feet in width,} to be a public highway, be laid out, located and established, and show:— (a) The general route of the proposed road; (b) over what lands it is proposed to be established; (c) who are the owners thereof; (d) whether such of them as can be found, consent thereto; (e) who of them do not consent; (f) the probable cost of the right-of-way where such consent is not had; (g) the necessity for and the advantages of the proposed road as follows, to-wit:

The East line of the proposed 40 foot right of way is described as follows Beginning at the N.W. corner of the S.W. 1/4 of the S.W. 1/4 of Sec. 24. T.2S. R.5E. thence south along the West side of sections 24 and 25, said T. and R. to a point 275 feet south of the S.W. corner of the N.W. 1/4 of the N.W. 1/4 of section 25. The portion of the old road between the above described starting point and terminus, which is situated East of the above described line, to be vacated and discontinued. The extra land required to make the 40 foot right of way west of said section line is owned by Geo. E. McKinney, J. A. Prew.

The object of this petition is that the ditch which is now within the road, and east of the above described section line, may be fenced out of the road, as it is a great damage to the road in its present condition.



REPORT OF ROAD VIEWERS.

TO THE HONORABLE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF GALLATIN COUNTY, MONTANA:

We, the undersigned Road Viewers, consisting of Thomas Lewis, J.E. Martin,
and G.M. Thorpe, who were duly appointed by J.L. Patterson
Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners of Gallatin
County Montana.

to a point 275 ft. south of the S.W. Cor. of the N.W. 1/4 of N.W. 1/4 of Sec. 25 T. 2 S. R. 5 E.

as described in the annexed petition, say, That on the 25th day of August

A. D., 1900 we assembled at the place designated in the petition, as the starting point of such proposed road and proceeded to view the same, and submit the following report:

1. The width of the proposed road, the description of the center line of the same, the length, how defined, the marks and sources, grades, character of ground, description of the land and owners of the same, over which the proposed road passes, and probable cost of constructing the said road, as follows:

We would recommend that the road be established 52 feet in width instead of 40 feet in width as petitioned for, and have so revised it. The right of way for said road to be 30 feet on the West side, ^{or such width as may be to the full width as it now stands.} and 22 feet on the East side of the following described section line to-wit: Beginning at the N.W. Corner of the S.W. 1/4 of S.W. 1/4 of Sec. 24 T. 2 S. R. 5 E. thence south along the section line between sections 23 + 24 and between sections 25 and 26, said Township and Range to a point about 500 feet south of the S.W. Corner of the N.W. 1/4 of N.W. 1/4 of Section 25, to a point where the irrigating ditch now enters said road from the west a distance of about 190 rods. The ditch which is now in the above described road to be filled up, and brush along the same cut, and a new ditch constructed, by the County, the same to be wholly East of the East line of the above described right of way. The fence along the East side of the said right of way to be constructed on the West side of said ditch. The land owners along the west side of the road, J.A. Pearson, and G.E. Mc Kirsay, agree to give the 22 feet for the road, change their fences, and allow the ditch to be constructed on their land, without charge to the county, provided Mr. J.L. Patterson who owns the land along the East side of the proposed road shall give 30 feet, and provided the County shall fill the old ditch and make a suitable paper (see their written agreement hereto ^{also the agreement of J.L. Patterson} attached). It will be necessary that stakes be set along the line of the right of way before the fences are changed, or ditch constructed.

We estimate the probable cost of cutting the bank along the old ditch, filling the old ditch suitable for a road, and constructing a new ditch on the west side of the road at \$200.00. We believe this will be less expense to the county than to obtain the road as petitioned for, and that the same will be a better road, as it will be wider and straight.

We would recommend that if the road be established as recommended by us, that the new ditch be constructed at once, so that the water may be taken out of the road.

5. The following facts, bearing upon the subject, which may be of importance to the Board:

In this matter two similar propositions are presented, which we hereto attach. We recommend the acceptance of Mr. Patterson's proposition as he agrees to give the right of way, allow the ditch to be constructed on his land and give \$50.00 toward the improvement of the road, while the parties only give the right of way, change their fences, and allow the construction of the ditch.

We believe said road to be practical and of public utility and necessity and do recommend the establishment of the same. and the acceptance of Mr. Patterson's proposition.
