The Undersigned, Your petitioners, Citizens of the United States, respectfully show and represent that they are residents of Road District No. 4, in the County of Gallatin State of Montana, where the road, hereafter petitioned for, is to be located, laid out and established, if this petition be granted; that the proposed road is a public convenience, and, we think, the public good requires it.

REPORT OF ROAD VIEWERS.

ROAD NO. 188

TO THE HONORABLE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF GALLATIN COUNTY, MONTANA:

We, the undersigned Road Viewers, consisting of Harris Kirk, W.L. McDonald,
and C.M. Thorne, appointed by the Board of County Commission-
 ers on the 9th day of July 1901.

appointed to view a proposed road running from the S.E. Corner of Sec. 1, T.3 S.
 R.3 E.

to a point on the Virginia City Road where the same is crossed by the line
 between sections 21 & 22 of T.2 S. R.3 E.
 as described in the annexed petition, say, That on the 8th day of Aug.

A. D., 1901 we assembled at the place designated in the petition, as the starting point of such proposed
 road and proceeded to view the same, and submit the following report:

1. The width of the proposed road, the description of the center line of the same, the length, how
 defined, the marks and sources, grades, character of ground, description of the land and owners of the
 same, over which the proposed road passes, and probable cost of constructing the said road, as follows:

The width of the proposed road is 60 feet.

The description of the center line of the proposed road is as
 follows to-wit: Beginning at the S.E. Corner of Sec. 1, T.3 S.
 R.3 E. thence west along the section line between sections
 1 and 12, and between sections 2, & 11, to the S.W. Corner
 of section 2, thence north along the west line of said
 Sec. 2, 1/4 mile more or less, to the top of the hill, thence
 having said line and running, ^{on a grade not exceeding 10%} North easterly, thence north
 westerly along the side of said hill & crossing said line,
 thence north easterly to a point on said line near the foot
 of said hill, thence north along said line to a point
 near the N. 1/4 Sec. Cor. of said Sec. 2 on the north side of
 the gulch, thence running, North easterly, and north westerly,
 around the east end of the hill on a grade not exceeding
 10% to a point on the East line of said Sec. 2.

The length of the proposed road is about 6 1/2 miles. The line of said road is defined by the U.S. Gov. corners and by stakes and mounds of stones.

The grades of the proposed road will not exceed 10% when properly constructed.

The ground is dry and suitable for road building.

The names of the land owners and the land owned by each ^{along the line of the proposed road} is shown by the annexed sketch.

The probable cost of opening the road for travel is \$250,000

No. damages are asked, all land owners consenting so far as we were able to see them.

4. The estimate of damages in excess of benefits to the owner of any land over which it is proposed to run the highway, as follows:

All owners of property abutting on the proposed road will be benefitted fully equal to the damages.

5. The following facts, bearing upon the subject, which may be of importance to the Board:

The land owners along the 1st 2 miles of the above described road have shown their desire for the road, by setting their fences back 30 feet from the line and signing the petition, from the north 1/4 sec. cor. of Sec. 34 the road is also open and traveled.

We find the road to be greatly needed as an outlet for settlers.

We believe said road _____ to be practical and _____ of public utility and necessity and do _____ recommend the establishment of the same.

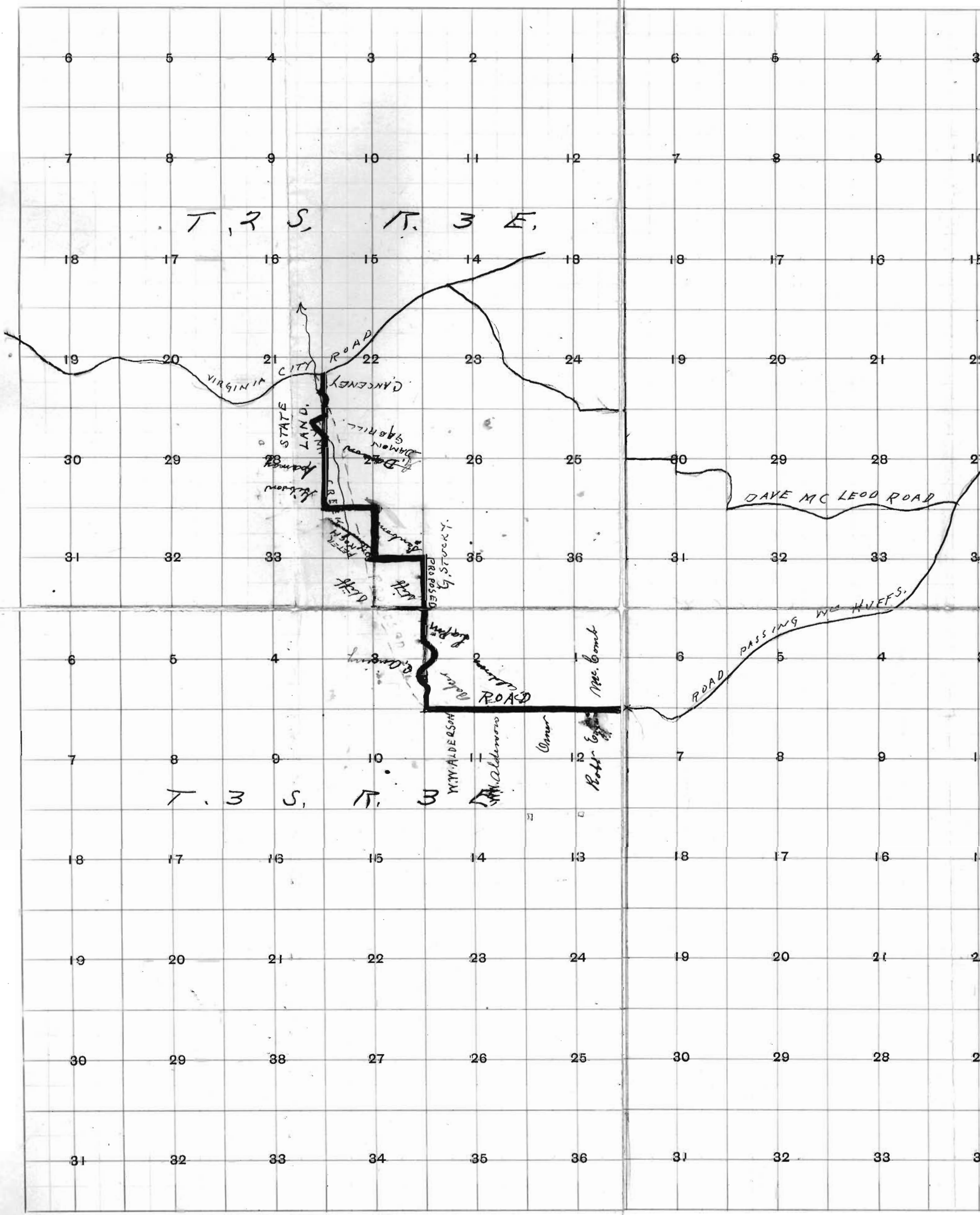
