# PETITION FOR ROAD

TO THE HON. BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, of Gallatin County, Montana:

The Undersigned, <sup>Freeholders</sup> Your petitioners, Citizens of the United States, respectfully show and represent that they are residents of Road Districts No. 1, 2 & 6 in the County of Gallatin State of Montana, where the road, hereafter petitioned for, is to be located, laid out and established, if this petition be granted; that the proposed road is a public convenience, and, we think, the public good requires it.

Your petitioners do respectfully ask and petition that a County Road, sixty feet in width, to be a public highway, to be laid out, located and established. and show:— (a) The general route of the proposed road; (b) over what lands it is proposed to be established; (c) who are the owners thereof; (d) whether such of them as can be found, consent thereto; (e) who of them do not consent; (f) the probable cost of the right-of-way where such consent is not had; (g) the necessity for and the advantages of the proposed road as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at the bridge over the Gallatin River at Logan, thence northwesterly by the most practicable route along or near the traveled road and along or near the old graded road, running up Cottonwood Creek, and along or near the West line of Section 17 T.3 N. R. 4 E, thence northwesterly to 16 Mile Creek.

The most of the road is on unsurveyed land.

(c) The owners of the land over which the road passes who consent to give the right of way & fees are as follows.  
J. M. Buleen, Geo & Con Stang, F. Forchler.

(g) The road is needed as an outlet for settlers, and for timber and for driving stock.



road passes and the cost of any bridges or grading necessary. You shall report the necessity for and the  
public convenience to be subserved by the highway, if opened, and whether the opening thereof or the  
change therein proposed should be made, and make and sign a report of your proceedings, as required by law.

Roads shall, in all cases, when practical, be laid out on subdivisional or section lines.

## REPORT OF ROAD VIEWERS.

ROAD NO. 218

TO THE HONORABLE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF GALLATIN COUNTY, MONTANA:

We, the undersigned Road Viewers, consisting of S. A. Callicott,  
N. M. Lewis + C. M. Thayer appointed by  
 your Honorable Body on June 3<sup>d</sup> 1903

appointed to view a proposed road running from Logan

to 16 miles

as described in the annexed petition, say, That on the 7<sup>th</sup> day of July  
 A. D., 1903 we assembled at the place designated in the petition, as the starting point of such proposed  
 road and proceeded to view the same, and submit the following report:

1. The width of the proposed road, the description of the center line of the same, the length, how  
 defined, the marks and sources, grades, character of ground, description of the land and owners of the  
 same, over which the proposed road passes, and probable cost of constructing the said road, as follows:

The width of the proposed road is 60 feet.  
 The description of the center line is as follows  
 to wit: - Beginning at the north end of  
 the Highway bridge over the Gallatin river at  
 Logan thence northeasterly along or near the  
 road as now traveled to Cottonwood Creek  
 thence up said creek looking on the south  
 side of the creek to near the head of the said  
 creek, thence N.E. along or near the traveled road  
 looking west of Valtier Cornrows fence and through  
 the land owned by W. M. Lewis to the summit  
 of the Hornshoe Mountain following the old side hill  
 grade to a point northwesterly from Mr. Copenhagen's  
 place

~~Entering said gulch near said mine, thence~~  
~~down said gulch to the healthy ship sheds~~  
~~along or near the traveled road, at said~~  
~~point we entered the old emigrant road,~~  
~~thence northeasterly along or near said old road~~

The length of the proposed road is about 16 miles.  
 a portion of the road is on unsurveyed land.  
 On the surveyed land crossed by the proposed road  
 we could not be sure of the sections crossed  
 without a survey. The annexed map shows the  
 approximate location of the road. At points where  
 the proposed road does not follow the traveled  
 road we marked the proposed line by setting

stakes or blazing trees  
The grades <sup>will not exceed 10% or 12%</sup> ~~in a few places might be 15%~~  
~~or more~~

With the exception of about one mile from the summit <sup>Chung</sup> to the Bend Mine the road is now traveled, excepting ~~to open this portion~~ to put the road in safe condition for travel would probably require the expenditure of ~~\$500~~ \$250 or \$300. We would recommend that the ~~road~~ <sup>road</sup> ~~portion from Logans~~ to the summit be put in a safe condition for travel at once, which would probably require an expense of \$250. or or \$300. or ~~the balance of the road~~ <sup>the balance of</sup> ~~road not so much at once but should be opened for the passage of stock~~.

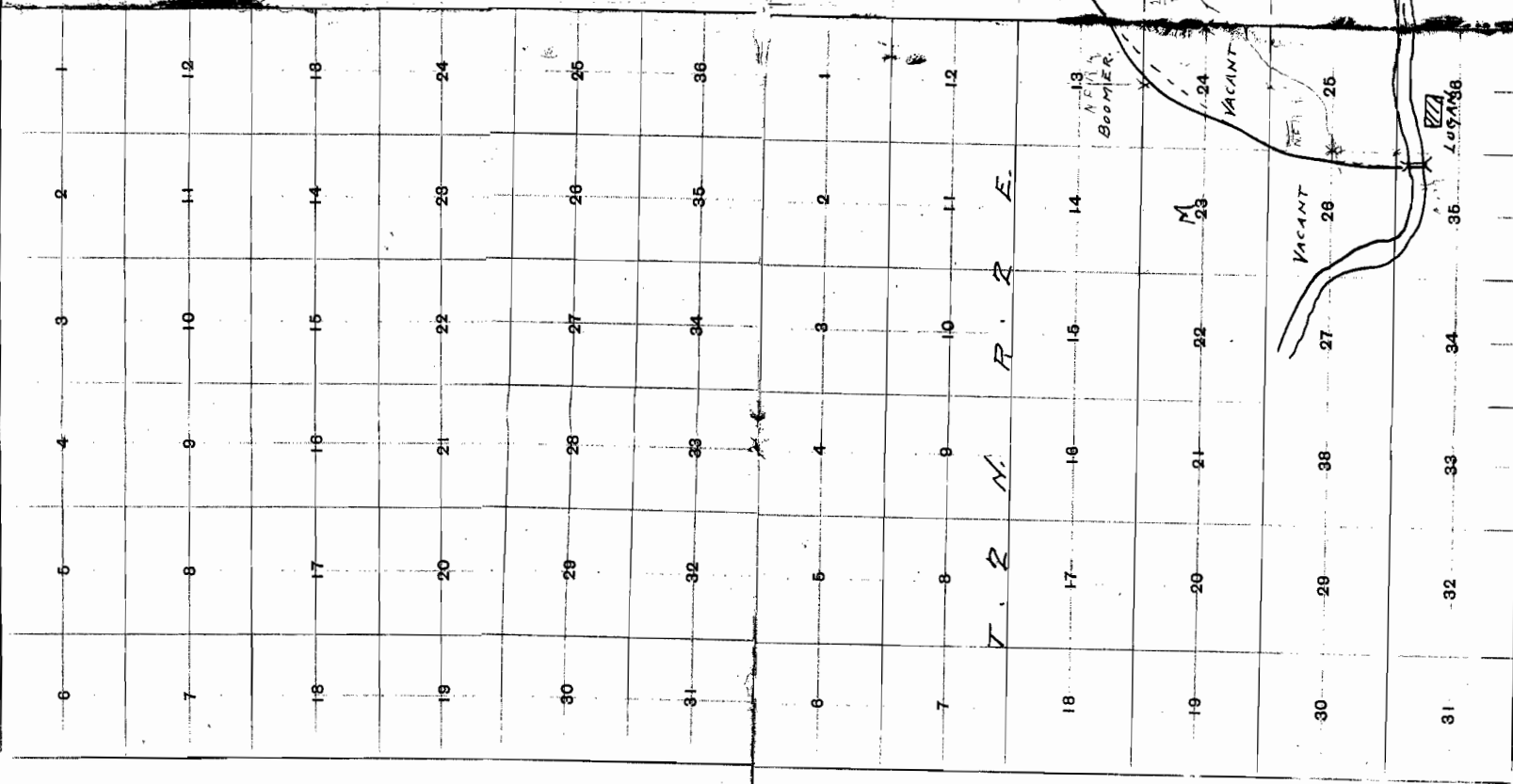

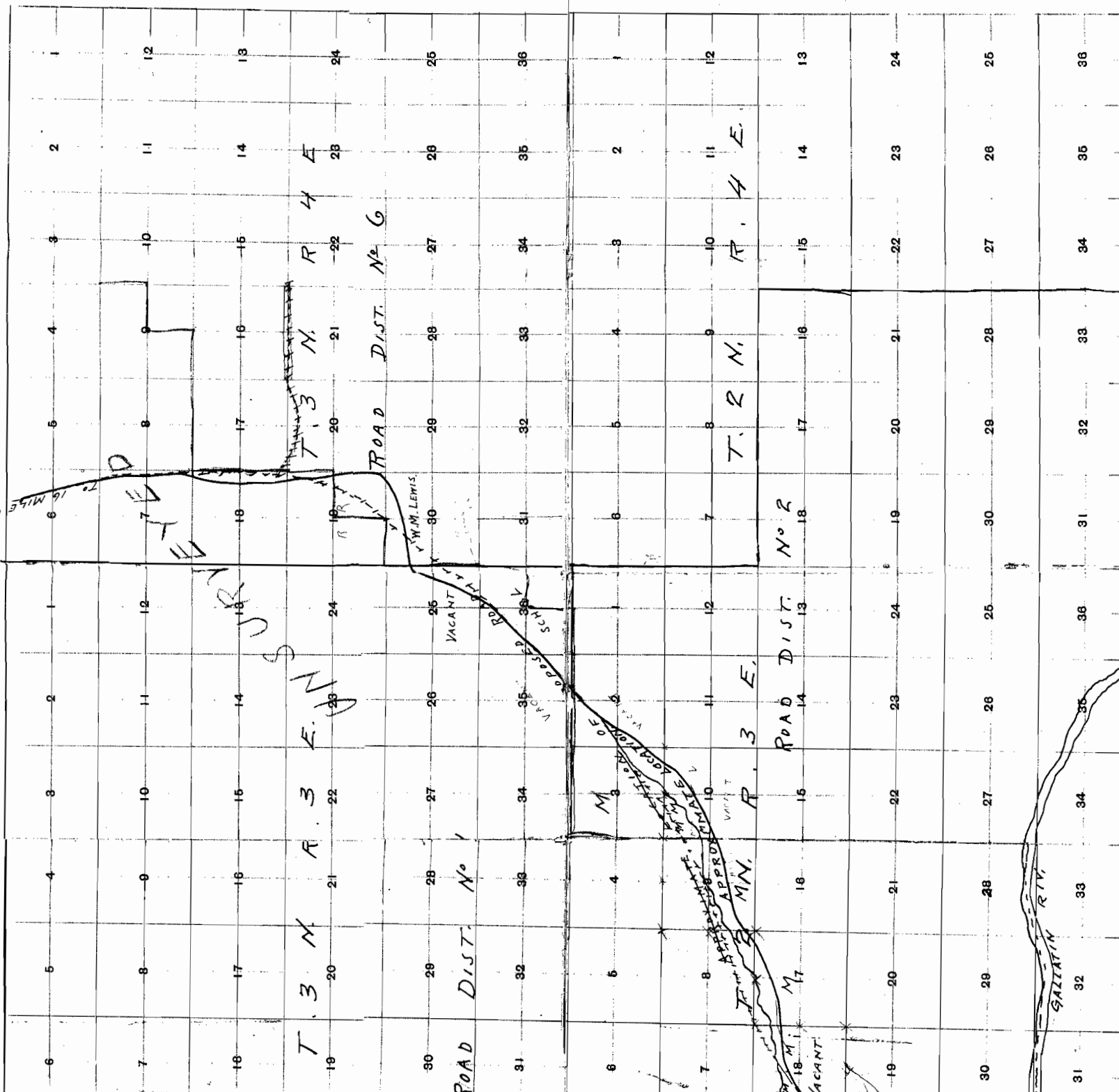
