CHANGE OF PETITION FOR ROAD

TO THE HON. BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, of Gallatin County, Montana:

The Undersigned, Your petitioners, Citizens of the United States, respectfully show and represent that they are residents of Road District No. 9, in the County of Gallatin State of Montana, where the road, hereafter petitioned for, is to be located, laid out and established, if this petition be granted; that the proposed road is a public convenience, and, we think, the public good requires it.

Your petitioners do respectfully ask and petition that a County Road, sixty feet in width, to be a public highway, be laid out, located and established, ^{and a portion of the old road vacated,} and show:— (a) The general route of the proposed road; (b) over what lands it is proposed to be established; (c) who are the owners thereof; (d) whether such of them as can be found, consent thereto; (e) who of them do not consent; (f) the probable cost of the right-of-way where such consent is not had; (g) the necessity for and the advantages of the proposed road as follows, to-wit:

(a+b) Beginning at a point in the County Road on the west line of Section 6 T. 14. R. 6 E. (unsurveyed) on the south side of Corbly Creek, thence northeasterly along the road as now traveled running through the South west 1/4 of said Section 6, crossing Corbly Creek and intersecting with the County road at a point in the South East 1/4 of said Section 6, at or near where the road as now traveled intersects the County Road as originally laid out, the portion of the County Road ^{as laid out in 1893} running from the above described starting point to the terminus of the proposed change, to be vacated and discontinued whenever this petition shall be granted. (c) The owners of the land over which the proposed change passes are as follows Chas H. Bazier S.W. 1/4 Sec. 6. Mrs. O. Green, S.E. 1/4 Sec. 6 ^(d) both consent to the proposed change and will do all work required to put the road in good condition for travel.

(g) The object of the proposed change is to put the road where it is now traveled and fence, on ground equally as good as when originally laid out, and leave the land in better shape for farming.

We, the undersigned Road Viewers, consisting of O. W. Smith,
Theodore Gervais, and C. M. Thorpe,

 A. D., 1903 we assembled at the place designated in the petition, as the starting point of such proposed road and proceeded to view the same, and submit the following report:

1. The width of the proposed road, the description of the center line of the same, the length, how defined, the marks and sources, grades, character of ground, description of the land and owners of the same, over which the proposed road passes, and probable cost of constructing the said road, as follows:

 The width of the proposed road is 60^{ft}.
 The description of the center line of the proposed road is as follows to wit:—
 Beginning at a point in the County Road on the west line of Section 6 T. 1 N. R. 6 E. (Unsurveyed) on the south side of Cobbley Creek, thence northeasterly along the road as now traveled running through the South west 1/4 of said Section 6, crossing Cobbley Creek and intersecting with the County road at a point in the South East 1/4 of said Section 6, at or near where the road as now traveled intersects the County Road as originally laid out. The portion of the County Road as laid out in 1893 running from the above described starting point to the terminus of the proposed Change to be vacated and discontinued whenever the petition shall be granted.

The length of the proposed change is _____
 The proposed change was surveyed at the time we viewed the road, the grades and character of the ground, are as good as on the old road. The S. W. 1/4 of said Sec. 6 is owned by Chas. H. Cozins and the South East 1/4 of said Sec 6 is owned by Mrs. O. Green, both of which consent to the change.
