PETITION FOR ROAD

TO THE HON. BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, of Gallatin County, Montana:

The Undersigned, Your petitioners, Citizens of the United States, respectfully show and represent that they are residents of Road District No. 2, in the County of Gallatin State of Montana, where the road, hereafter petitioned for, is to be located, laid out and established, if this petition be granted; that the proposed road is a public convenience, and, we think, the public good requires it.

Your petitioners do respectfully ask and petition that a County Road, sixty feet in width, to be a public highway, to be laid out, located and established. and show:— (a) The general route of the proposed road; (b) over what lands it is proposed to be established; (c) who are the owners thereof; (d) whether such of them as can be found, consent thereto; (e) who of them do not consent; (f) the probable cost of the right-of-way where such consent is not had; (g) the necessity for and the advantages of the proposed road as follows, to-wit:

Description of proposed road

The proposed road runs East of the west line of the S. 1st corner of Section 32 T. 1 N. R. 2 E. thence East on the South side of section line of the S. W. 1/4 of section 21 N. R. 2 E. 80 rods thence South 1/2 mile on the west side of the subdivision line of Section 5 T. 2 N. R. 2 E. Thence South 1/2 mile on the subdivision line of S. 1/4 T. 2 N. R. 2 E. Thence West on the section line between S. 5 and S. 8 T. 2 N. R. 2 E. to the intersection of the old road. Severat Viggerson is the owner of the west 1/2 of section 5 and Mrs. W. F. Sloan is the owner of the S. E. 1/4 of section 5 and the N. W. 1/4 of section 8 T. 2 N. R. 2 E. both parties consent to give right of way and right of way. Nothing but the old road runs diagonally across said S. 5 thereby making it almost worthless unless said road is changed as petitioned for.

PETITION FOR ROAD

The Undersigned, Your petitioners, Citizens of the United States, respectfully show and represent that they are residents of Road District No. 2, in the County of Gallatin State of Montana, where the road, hereafter petitioned for, is to be located, laid out and established, if this petition be granted; that the proposed road is a public convenience, and, we think, the public good requires it.

Your petitioners do respectfully ask and petition that a County Road, sixty feet in width, to be a public highway, to be laid out, located and established. and show:— (a) The general route of the proposed road; (b) over what lands it is proposed to be established; (c) who are the owners thereof; (d) whether such of them as can be found, consent thereto; (e) who of them do not consent; (f) the probable cost of the right-of-way where such consent is not had; (g) the necessity for and the advantages of the proposed road as follows, to-wit:

A change in the road running up the Madison Valley known as the river road in Section 5 T. 2. S. R. 2 E. The present road runs through the N. 1/2 of sec 5 in a diagonal direction thereby damaging said 1/2 as to make it worthless for any purpose we would respectfully ask that the same be laid out on the line as marked out in the accompanying maps—that is, beginning at a point in a line of the north line of said 1/2 and instead of running through following the section line in an easterly direction to the subdivision line between the N. 1/2 and N. E. 1/4 of said section 5, running thence on said subdivision line south one mile to the section line between section 5 and 8, thence west to said section line to the intersection of the old road and would respectfully ask that the old roads running through the N. 1/2 of sect 5 to be discontinued.
