# PETITION FOR ROAD

TO THE HON. BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, of Gallatin County, Montana:

The Undersigned, Your petitioners, Citizens of the United States, respectfully show and represent that they are residents of Road District No. 6, in the County of Gallatin State of Montana, where the road, hereafter petitioned for, is to be located, laid out and established, if this petition be granted; that the proposed road is a public convenience, and, we think, the public good requires it.

Your petitioners do respectfully ask and petition that a County Road 100 feet in width, to be a public highway, to be laid out, located and established. and show:— (a) the general route of the proposed road; (b) over what lands it is proposed to be established; (c) who are the owners thereof; (d) whether such of them as can be found, consent thereto; (e) who of them do not consent; (f) the probable cost of the right-of-way where such consent is not had; (g) the necessity for and the advantages of the proposed road as follows, to-wit:

Commencing at the 1/2 mile corner Stone  
In the center of section (31) 4N 4E on Callantine  
Road Running due East one half mile thence  
North about 200 yds to intersect manderson  
road

(c) J. B. Wood + C. E. Jordan

J. B. Wood agreeing to give a Forty foot  
Road 1/2 mile the balance (all on road E)

(g) to make a more direct Route from  
one road to the other + a better Route for road  
+ avoiding two bad cuts where snow drifts
