# PETITION FOR ROAD

TO THE HON. BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, of Gallatin County, Montana :

**The Undersigned**, Your petitioners, Citizens of the United States, respectfully show and represent that they are residents of Road District No. 2, in the County of Gallatin State of Montana, where the road, hereafter petitioned for, is to be located, laid out and established, if this petition be granted; that the proposed road is a public convenience, and, we think, the public good requires it.

Your petitioners do respectfully ask and petition that a County Road, sixty feet in width, to be a public highway, to be laid out, located and established, and show:— (a) The general route of the proposed road; (b) over what lands it is proposed to be established; (c) who are the owners thereof; (d) whether such of them as can be found, consent thereto; (e) who of them do not consent; (f) the probable cost of the right-of-way where such consent is not had; (g) the necessity for and the advantages of the proposed road as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at the N.E. corner of the N.W. 1/4 of Sec. 34 T. 1 S. R. 2 E. running thence N and immediately south of the section line between S. 34 and S. 29 of T. 1 S. R. 2 E. 1/4 of a mile thence south of subdivision line between the East 1/2 and the West 1/2 of the north west 1/4 of Sec. 34 T. 1 S. R. 2 E. 1/2 mile to the intersection of old road. The road runs over lands owned by H. Everson Mrs H. Everson and Stewart Eiggerson. All owners consent to give right of way their names appearing on petition. The change will greatly enhance the value of the land as well as the road.
