# PETITION FOR ROAD

TO THE HON. BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, of Gallatin County, Montana:

The Undersigned, Your petitioners, Citizens of the United States, respectfully show and represent that they are residents of Road District No. 6, in the County of Gallatin State of Montana, where the road, hereafter petitioned for, is to be located, laid out and established, if this petition be granted; that the proposed road is a public convenience, and, we think, the public good requires it.

Your petitioners do respectfully ask and petition that a County Road, ~~fourty~~<sup>forty</sup> feet in width, to be a public highway, to be laid out, located and established. and show:— (a) The general route of the proposed road; (b) over what lands it is proposed to be established; (c) who are the owners thereof; (d) whether such of them as can be found, consent thereto; (e) who of them do not consent; (f) the probable cost of the right-of-way where such consent is not had; (g) the necessity for and the advantages of the proposed road as follows, to-wit:

Commencing at a point on the Bulew road at the center of section line between sections 22 and 27 Twp. 3 N. R. 4 E. and running east on the sec. line between the east half of sec. 22 owned by St. A. Calantine and the east half of sec. 27 owned by Mrs. Hattie Cowan. Damage a 1/2 wire fence. Complete Thence east between sec. 23 owned by B. F. Stiff and sec. 26 part Gov. land the rest owned by W. M. Stiff And east between sec. 24 owned by Fronie Stiff Chas. Myers, and Wm. Myers (Wm. Myers damages \$15 and sec. 25 owned by P. Elliott damage \$60 joining Dry Creek road at this point.

This road is needed for outlet for settlers, as B. F. Stiff and W. M. Stiff are fenced in and have no outlet to public road.



road passes and the cost of any bridges or grading necessary. You shall report the necessity for and the  
public convenience to be subserved by the highway, if opened, and whether the opening thereof or the  
change therein proposed should be made, and make and sign a report of your proceedings, as required by law.

Roads shall, in all cases, when practical, be laid out on subdivisional or section lines.

## REPORT OF ROAD VIEWERS.

ROAD NO 232

TO THE HONORABLE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF GALLATIN COUNTY, MONTANA:

We, the undersigned Road Viewers, consisting of Frank Callentine,  
Byron Chidester, and C. M. Thorpe appointed by your  
honorable body on Oct. 15<sup>th</sup> 1903.

appointed to view a proposed road running from the Buler Road to the  
Dry Creek Road

as described in the annexed petition, say, That on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of November  
A. D., 1903 we assembled at the place designated in the petition, as the starting point of such proposed  
road and proceeded to view the same, and submit the following report:

1. The width of the proposed road, the description of the center line of the same, the length, how  
defined, the marks and sources, grades, character of ground, description of the land and owners of the  
same, over which the proposed road passes, and probable cost of constructing the said road, as follows:

The width of the proposed road is forty feet.  
The description of the center line is as follows to wit:—  
Beginning at the  $\frac{1}{4}$  section corner between sections  
22 and 27 T.3N. R. 4E. said point being in the  
County Road known as the Buler Road, thence East  
along section line between sections 22 & 27, between 23 & 26  
and between 24 & 25 to the intersection with the County  
Road known as the Dry Creek Road, Except at hill  
on south line of S.E.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of land Sec. 22 where we leave the  
section line running north east and south east to back to section  
line, and at big hill near S.E. corner of Sec. 22 where we  
leave the section line running first north of the line and  
then south of the line, and back to said section line a  
short distance east of said section corner,  
And at big gulch on south line of Sec. 23 where we  
leave the section line running on a grade not exceeding  
10% and crossing said gulch north of the section line  
and running back to the line east of said gulch,  
At bluff on west side of Dry Creek we leave section line  
running north of said line down a gulch on grade  
not exceeding 10% and back to section line at foot  
of bluff. Along the south line of the S.E.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of S.W.  $\frac{1}{4}$   
and the S.W.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of S.E.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of section 24 said T. & R. owned  
by Chas. Myers, M. P. C. Elliot gives all of the right of way  
south of the section line and we have so viewed the  
road. The road is marked by stakes where it leaves  
the section lines. A survey will be required to establish

the section lines as most of the corners are lost or disputed.

The length of the proposed road is about  $2\frac{1}{2}$  miles the grades will be about 10% to 12%, the ground over which the proposed road passes is suitable for road building.

See accompanying sketch for land owners names. The probable cost of constructing the proposed road is \$375,00

3. The names of the land owners who do not consent, and the amount of damages claimed by each, as follows:

W. A. Myers claims for fence material for 1/4 mile \$15.00

4. The estimate of damages in excess of benefits to the owner of any land over which it is proposed to run the highway, as follows:

to W. A. Myers \$15.00  
to Mrs. N. Cowan 75.00

5. The following facts, bearing upon the subject, which may be of importance to the Board:

The road is needed as an outlet for settlers.
