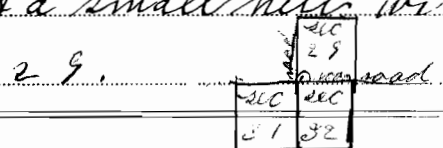
PETITION FOR ROAD

TO THE HON. BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, of Gallatin County, Montana :

The Undersigned, Your petitioners, Citizens of the United States, respectfully show and represent that they are residents of Road District No....., in the County of Gallatin State of Montana, where the road, hereafter petitioned for, is to be located, laid out and established, if this petition be granted; that the proposed road is a public convenience, and, we think, the public good requires it.

Your petitioners do respectfully ask and petition that a County Road, sixty feet in width, to be a public highway, to be laid out, located and established. and show:— (a) The general route of the proposed road; (b) over what lands it is proposed to be established; (c) who are the owners thereof; (d) whether such of them as can be found, consent thereto; (e) who of them do not consent; (f) the probable cost of the right-of-way where such consent is not had; (g) the necessity for and the advantages of the proposed road as follows, to-wit:

- (a) Commencing at a point in the Road to Horse Shoe Mts. - No 154, where it leaves the section line between Sec. 31 and 32, T3N, R4E, and continue north on the sec line between Sec 31 and 32, and Sec 29 and 30, same T & R. to where the road as now platted runs up a gulch to the mountains. Also —
Commencing at a point in the Simer road - No 170 - , where it leaves the section line between Sec 29 and 32, T3N, R4E, and continue west to intersect with the road to the Horse Shoe Mts., at the southwest corner of Sec 29, said T and R.
- (b) Above described.
- (c) N. Callentine.
- (d) (Consents)
- (e) (none)
- (g) The road properly should be on the section line as it jogs into the southwest quarter of Sec 29, making it very hard to cultivate conveniently, and the change as petitioned for making so good a road as where it now is, with the exception of a small hill with a small curve in corner of sec.
