P E T I T I O N F O R R O A D .

TO THE HONORABLE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS,
of Gallatin County, Montana.

THE UNDERSIGNED, Your Petitioners, Citizens of the United States, respectfully show and represent that **they** are residents of Road District No. _____, in the County of Gallatin, State of Montana, where the road, hereafter petitioned for, is to be located, laid out and established, if this petition be granted; that the proposed road is a public convenience, and, we think, the public good requires it.

Your petitioners **do** respectfully ask and petition that a County Road, sixty feet in width, to be a public highway, to be laid out, located and established, and show:- (a) The general route of the proposed road; (b) over what lands it is proposed to be established; (c) who are the owners thereof; (d) whether such of them as can be found, consent thereto; (e) who of them do not consent; (f) the probable cost **of** the right-of-way where such consent is not had; (g) the necessity for and the advantages of the proposed road as follows, to-wit:

Commencing at the **east** end of Main street as shown by the recorded plat of Central Park, Montana, and running thence easterly along the north line of the Northern Pacific Railway right of way to the place where the railway right of way intersects the east boundary line of **West ½ S.W. 4th** Section 20, Twp. 1 N.R. 4 East; thence south across said railway right of way to connect with the present county road which lies on south of said railway right of way.

The lands embraced in said proposed road belong to The Gallatin Ranch Company, A.A. Dawes and D. A. Cheney; such owners have consented to this road per endorsement hereon.

The proposed road with necessary crossing to connect ~~with it~~ it with the road on the south side of the railway right of way, will be an extension of the present road from Manhattan to Belgrade, and will straighten out several turns in the present road; the proposed road will cross the railway tracks at a point where where

the tracks and passing trains can be seen readily from some distance on either side, making the crossing a safe one.

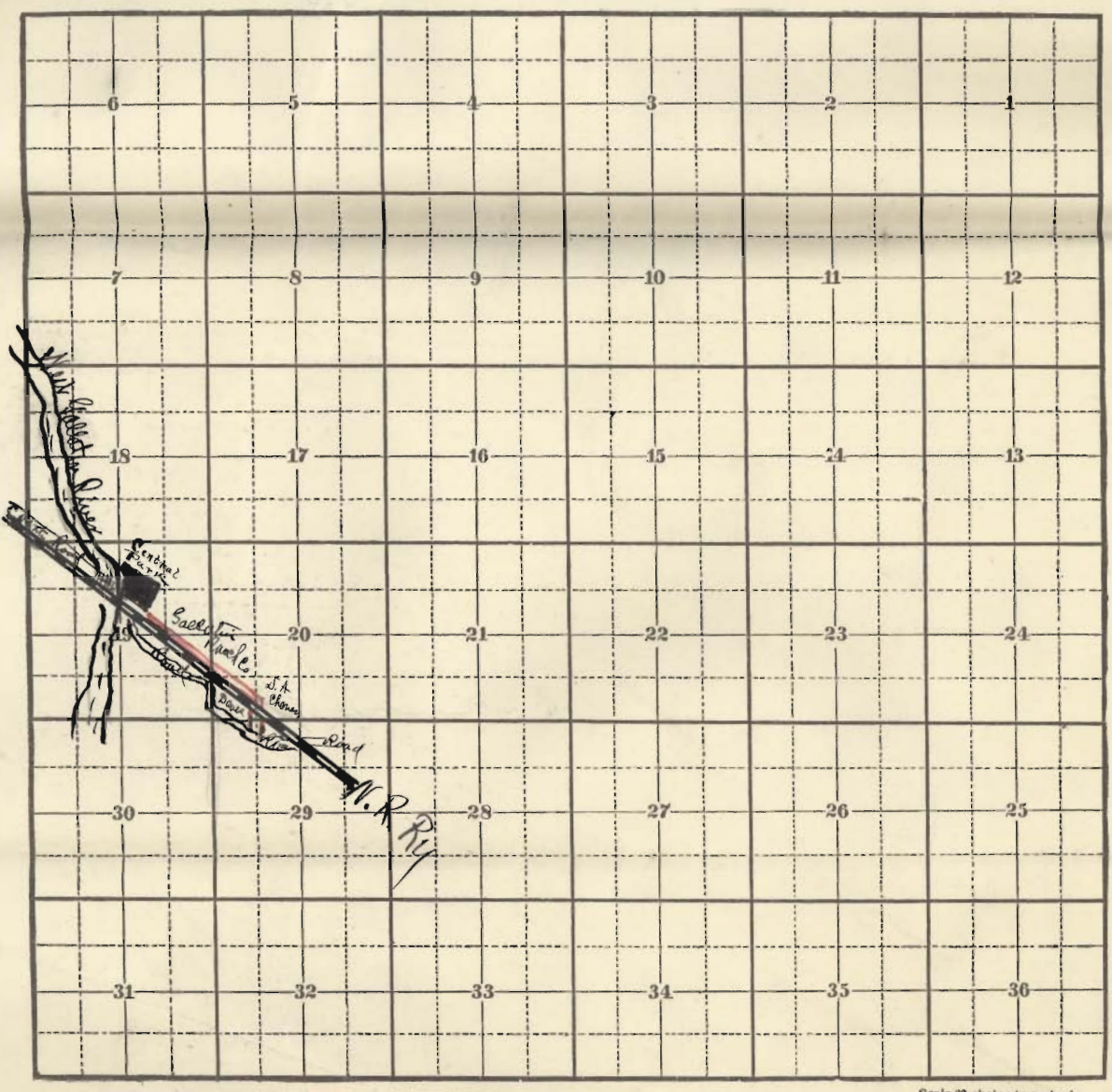
