PETITION FOR ROAD

TO THE HON. BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, of Gallatin County, Montana:

The ~~undersigned~~ ^{undersigned} ~~and free-holders~~ petitioners, Citizens of the United States, respectfully show and represent that they are residents of Road District No. 2, in the County of Gallatin State of Montana, where the road, hereafter petitioned for, is to be located, laid out and established, if this petition be granted; that the proposed road is a public convenience, and, we think, the public good requires it.

Your petitioners do respectfully ask and petition that a County Road, sixty feet in width, to be a public highway, to be laid out, located and established. and show:— (a) The general route of the proposed road; (b) over what lands it is proposed to be established; (c) who are the owners thereof; (d) whether such of them as can be found, consent thereto; (e) who of them do not consent; (f) the probable cost of the right-of-way where such consent is not had; (g) the necessity for and the advantages of the proposed road as follows, to-wit:

a Beginning at the south east corner of Section 12, in Township ~~Two~~ ^{One} South of Range Two East; thence north one mile more or less, on section and Township line to the north-east corner of said section; thence east one mile on section line,

b, c, shown by "Exhibit A" hereto attached and hereto made a part.

d, e All abutting land owners consent to the opening of the road.

f The following named residents of said road district need said road in order to reach their lands and lands covered by homestead entries made by them. Said parties travel through each others fields and have no other means for reaching a public highway from their said lands, but proposed road, if opened will afford them a way out from their lands to the public highway. Names of persons so benefitted by proposed road: C. V. Seallard, J. E. Seallard, Ben Jesselle, Bert Babcock, Emmett Lee, and ^{Orley} ~~Thos~~ Churchill. Also this road, if opened, will be of great convenience to many others as a road to market, since same will have better grades for hauling, and will shorten the distance to market.

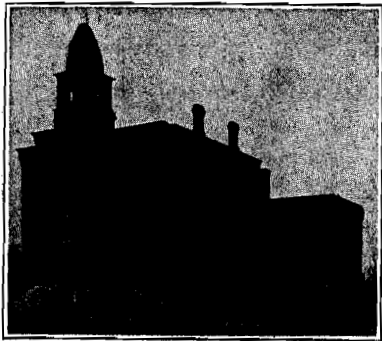
