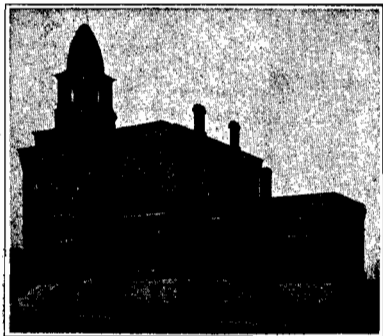

Gentlemen:-

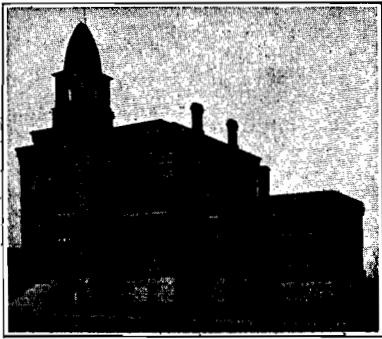
