# REPORT OF ROAD VIEWERS.

ROAD NO. 271

TO THE HONORABLE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF GALLATIN COUNTY, MONTANA:

We, the undersigned Road Viewers, consisting of John M. Robinson  
 + C.M. Thayer, two of the Road Viewers appointed to view  
 a proposed road running thru Co. Road at Dove Meadows,  
 to the Boyeman + Salasville Road, say that on June 23  
 appointed to view a proposed road running from 19.6 we met and on account  
 of rain adjourned until July 24.

as described in the annexed petition, say, That on the 24 day of July  
 A. D., 1906 we assembled at the place designated in the petition, as the starting point of such proposed  
 road and proceeded to view the same, and submit the following report: Walt Kirbel the  
other viewer not being present

1. The width of the proposed road, the description of the center line of the same, the length, how  
 defined, the marks and sources, grades, character of ground, description of the land and owners of the  
 same, over which the proposed road passes, and probable cost of constructing the said road, as follows:

The width of the proposed road is 40 feet.

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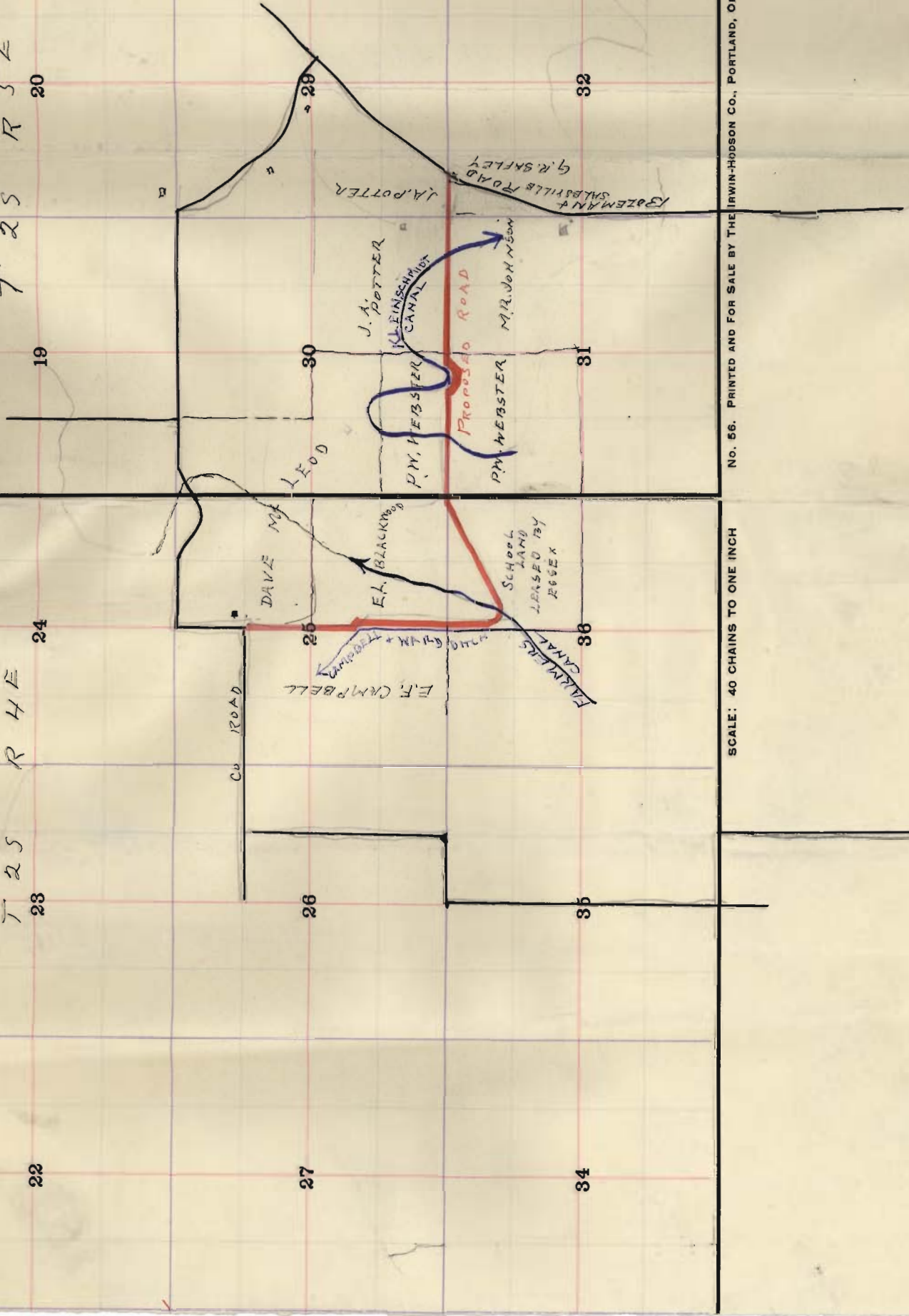
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
