PETITION FOR ROAD

TO THE HON. BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, of Gallatin County, Montana:

The Undersigned, ^{and freeholders} Your petitioners, Citizens of the United States, respectfully show and represent that they are residents of Road District No. 4, ^{except M. F. McLaughlin, J. M. Ping and A. B. Morgan} in the County of Gallatin State of Montana, where the road, hereafter petitioned for, is to be located, laid out and established, if this petition be granted; that the proposed road is a public convenience, and, we think, the public good, requires it.

Your petitioners do respectfully ask and petition that a County Road, ^{forty} ~~sixty~~ feet in width, to be a public highway, to be laid out, located and established. and show:— (a) The general route of the proposed road; (b) over what lands it is proposed to be established; (c) who are the owners thereof; (d) whether such of them as can be found, consent thereto; (e) who of them do not consent; (f) the probable cost of the right-of-way where such consent is not had; (g) the necessity for and the advantages of the proposed road as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at the "Crow Road" at a bridge on Foster Creek in the North part of sec. 21. thence running a South westerly direction away and over said Foster Creek through the N.W. corner diagonally of Sec 28 and so in same manner through Sec 29 and the South East corner of Sec 30. thence southerly through the East part of Sec 31, each of above named Sec. being in Township 2, N. R. 5, E. thence south westerly through the N.W. corner of the N.E. 1/4 of Sec 6 T. 1, N. R. 5 E. continuing in same direction through the South East corner of the N.W. 1/4 of said Sec 6. thence south westerly diagonally through South West 1/4 same Sec. continuing south west and intersecting with the Dry Creek Road in Sec 12. 1 N. 4 E. that S. H. Crow is the owner of said Secs. 21, 28 & 29, and Wm. V. Sasser the South East 1/4 Sec 30. W. B. Huffine Sec 31. Frank Collins the N.E. 1/4 Sec 6. Sol. Miller ^{Marius} the West 1/2 of said Sec 6 up to the point of such intersection with Dry Creek Road owned by W. H. Cox. All owners of land over which said road passes consent to same and demand no damage for right of way. ^{but S. H. Crow and Sol Miller ask damages for fencing the probable cost being \$600.00.}
