The Undersigned, Your petitioners, Citizens of the United States, respectfully show and repre-
sent that they are residents of and freeholders in Road District No $m{arphi}$ , in the County of Gallatin,
State of Montana, and taxable therein for road purposes, where the road, hereafter petitioned for, is to be
located, laid out and established, if this petition be granted; that the proposed road is a public conven-
ience, and, we think, the public good requires it.

(f) The probable cost of such right-of-way where such consent is not had.
(g) The necessity for and advantages of the proposed road as follows, to-wit:
