# Petition for Road.

To The Hon. Board of County Commissioners, of Gallatin County, Mont.:

THE UNDERSIGNED, Your petitioners, Citizens of the United States, respectfully show and represent that they are residents of and freeholders in Road District No. .... 6....., in the County of Gallatin, State of Montana, and taxable therein for road purposes, where the road, hereinafter petitioned for, is to be located, laid out and established, if this petition be granted; that the proposed road is a public convenience, and, we think, the public good requires it.

Your petitioners do respectfully ask and petition that a County Road.....-60-..... feet in width, to be a public highway, to be laid out, located and established.

And show

- (a) The general route of the proposed road.
- (b) Over what lands it is proposed to be established.
- (c) Who are the owners thereof.
- (d) Whether such of them as can be found, consent thereto.
- (e) Who of them do not consent.
- (f) The probable cost of such right-of-way where such consent is not had.
- (g) The necessity for and advantages of the proposed road as follows, to-wit:

(a) The general route of the road is to follow down the ridge, along the line of the old abandoned road, in a north-westerly direction across the NE 1/4 of Sec 31, T4N R5E

(b+c) The proposed road will be over about 100 to 150 ft in the SW Corner of N 24 1/4 sec 32, T4N R5E, belonging to C. E. Jordan; and diagonally across the NE 1/4 said sec 31, belonging to Accola Bros

(d) C. E. Jordan consents, Accola Bros have not given their opinion

(e) ————— Explained

(f) The probable cost will be the expense of moving one half mile of fence, the material being on the ground.

(9) This road is to replace and discontinue the present road between the NE 1/4 and the SE 1/4 of said sec 31.

The road as outlined is along a gravelly ridge with easy grades and travel can thus avoid the several hills in the road along the west side of the NE 1/4 of said sec 31.

This road will be the main thoroughfare between the Flathead wheat section to the Milwaukee R.R.
