# Petition for Road.

To The Hon. Board of County Commissioners, of Gallatin County, Mont.:

THE UNDERSIGNED, Your petitioners, Citizens of the United States, respectfully show and represent that they are residents of and freeholders in Road District No....., in the County of Gallatin, State of Montana, and taxable therein for road purposes, where the road, hereinafter petitioned for, is to be located, laid out and established, if this petition be granted; that the proposed road is a public convenience, and, we think, the public good requires it.

Your petitioners do respectfully ask and petition that a County Road..... feet in width, to be a public highway, to be laid out, located and established.

And show

- (a) The general route of the proposed road.
- (b) Over what lands it is proposed to be established.
- (c) Who are the owners thereof.
- (d) Whether such of them as can be found, consent thereto.
- (e) Who of them do not consent.
- (f) The probable cost of such right-of-way where such consent is not had.
- (g) The necessity for and advantages of the proposed road as follows, to-wit:

(A) Change starts from the N.W. corner of the S.W. 1/4 of the N. W. 1/4 of Sec. 23, T. P. # 2 N. range 2 east, thence direct east on quarter sec. line for a distance of about 1/5 of a mile, thence south-east following the rim of hill to Cottonwood creek on quarter sec. line, following quarter sec. line south to a point between Secs 23 and 26, where old road is a gain followed.

(B) Farming land.

(C) Abbott & Miller, Logan, Montana.

(D) They do.

(E) None.

(F) Nothing.

(G) As old road now runs, it cuts diagonally through eighty acres of farming land belonging to Abbott & Miller, which they are now unable to fence to any advantage and by the slight change asked for, it will give the same good road, in fact a better road for the public and enable the land to be fenced profitably.

THE HON. BOARD COUNTY COMMISSIONERS:

Gentlemen,

We hereby petition for permission to make a slight change in what is known as the Logan and Magpie public road and in making such change we will comply with all laws and regulations governing the changing of established roads.

As road now runs it cuts diagonally through eighty acres of our land which we are now unable to fence to any advantage and by the slight change asked for, it will give the same good road, of no longer distance and enable us to fence this land profitable.

The Change we ask for is as follows;

Change starts from the N.W. corner of the S.W. 1/4 of the N.W. 1/4 of Section 23, T. P. # 2, N. range 2 East, thence direct east on quarter section line for a distance of about one fifth of a mile, thence south east following the rim of hill to Cottonwood creek, cross Cottonwood creek on quarter section line, follow quarter section line south to a point between Sections 23 and 26 where old road is again followed.
