To The Hon. Board of County Commissioners, of Gallatin County, Mont.:

THE UNDERSIGNED, Your petitioners, Citizens of the United States, respectfully show and represent that they are residents of and freeholders in Road District No. 10....., in the County of Gallatin, State of Montana, and taxable therein for road purposes, where the road, hereinafter petitioned for, is to be located, laid out and established, if this petition be granted; that the proposed road is a public convenience, and, we think, the public good requires it.

Your petitioners do respectfully ask and petition that a County Road *Forty*..... feet in width, to be a public highway, to be laid out, located and established.
