Petition for Road.

To The Hon. Board of County Commissioners, of Gallatin County, Mont.:

THE UNDERSIGNED, Your petitioners, Citizens of the United States, respectfully show and represent that they are residents of and freeholders in Road District No. 4, in the County of Gallatin, State of Montana, and taxable therein for road purposes, where the road, hereinafter petitioned for, is to be located, laid out and established, if this petition be granted; that the proposed road is a public convenience, and, we think, the public good requires it.

Your petitioners do respectfully ask and petition that a County Road 40 feet in width, to be a public highway, to be laid out, located and established.

And show

- (a) The general route of the proposed road.
- (b) Over what lands it is proposed to be established.
- (c) Who are the owners thereof.
- (d) Whether such of them as can be found, consent thereto.
- (e) Who of them do not consent.
- (f) The probable cost of such right-of-way where such consent is not had.
- (g) The necessity for and advantages of the proposed road as follows, to-wit:

(a) Beginning at a point in the present travelled road near the center of Section 25 T3S R4E, where this road is closed by a gate; running thence South easterly along the present travelled Bear Creek road to a point about 30 rods south of the S.E. Corner of Said Sec 25.

(b) Explained

(c) All of Sec 25 and the NE 1/4 of Sec 36 belong to F K Armstrong.

(d) Do not know Armstrong has not said whether ^{or not} he objects

(e)

(f) Not Explained

(g) This is a canyon road and has been travelled for over 20 years, and is used to quite an extent by those hauling timber and wood. also farm crops to market

The county has worked the road up to a point near the ~~west~~ ^{west} line of ~~the~~ Sec 25, and the road has been platted up to the point near the center of Sec 25, where it is obstructed by the gate mentioned.

In opening this road it will be necessary to expend about \$50 or \$75, in grading and for culverts, ~~and~~
