To the Honorable Board of County Commissioners of Gallatin County, State of Montana.

We the undersigned citizens and residents of the county of Gallatin, State of Montana, hereby represent to your honorable board that that part of the public road running east and west along the Northern Pacific Railway track, and parallel thereto, <sup>in section 36, Township 1, 20 N 5 East</sup> is entirely too narrow and inadequate to accomodate the public travel thereon. The inconvenience to the public especially in passing automobiles and heavily loaded wagons is often great and causes much trouble to parties in going in opposite direction.

We therefore hereby petition your honorable board to establish the maximum width road for the road above referred to, to-wit:- That part of the public highway running east and west along the Northern Pacific Railway track in Section 36, Township One, South, Range Five, East.
