Petition For Road.

To The Hon. Board of County Commissioners, of Gallatin County, Mont.:

The Undersigned, Your petitioners, Citizens of the United States, respectfully show and represent that they are residents of and freeholders in Road District No. 121....., in the County of Gallatin, State of Montana, and taxable therein for road purposes, where the road, hereafter petitioned for, is to be located, laid out and established, if this petition be granted; that the proposed road is a public convenience, and, we think, the public good requires it.

Your petitioners do respectfully ask and petition that a County Road forty..... feet in width, to be a public highway, to be laid out, located and established.

And show:

- (a) The general route of the proposed road.
- (b) Over what lands it is proposed to be established.
- (c) Who are the owners thereof.
- (d) Whether such of them as can be found, consent thereto.
- (e) Who of them do not consent.
- (f) The probable cost of such right-of-way where such consent is not had.
- (g) The necessity for and advantages of the proposed road as follows, to-wit:

~~(a) The general route of said proposed road is as follows:~~
~~Beginning at the South East corner of Section Thirty-two, in Township~~
~~One, North of Range Three East, in Gallatin County, Montana, thence~~
~~extending North on Section lines a distance of four miles: Thence~~
~~running East on Section line a distance of One mile, until proposed~~
~~road shall intersect the public highway running north and south along~~
~~the east line of Section 16, said township and range.~~

~~(b & c) The following is a description of the lands~~
~~over which it is proposed to establish said road, and the names of~~
~~the owners thereof: A strip of ground 20 feet in width off the west~~
~~side of Sections 21 and 33, and a strip twenty feet in width off the~~
~~east side of Section 17, all in Township 1, North of Range Three~~
~~East, and belonging to H. S. Buell Land Company: Twenty feet off the~~
~~east side of the South West Quarter of Section 32, said Township~~
~~and Range, belonging to F. I. Duffin: Twenty feet off the east side~~
~~of the North East Quarter of Section 32, said Township and range,~~
~~belonging to E. Bos: Twenty feet off the West side of Sections~~
~~16 and 28, and 20 feet off the East side of the South Half of Section~~
~~20, said Township and range, belonging in trust to the State of~~
~~Montana: Twenty feet off the East side of the North East Quarter~~
~~of Section 20, said Township and range, belonging to Webb Vincent:~~
~~Twenty feet off the South side of Section 9, said Township and range,~~
~~belonging to the Manhattan Company. And Twenty feet off the North~~
~~side of Section 16, said Township and range, belonging in trust to~~
~~the State of Montana.~~

(d) The following named owners of lands consent to the opening of said proposed road:

H. S. Buell Land Company, The Manhattan Company, F. F. Duffin, Webb Vincent. *A. J. Rutledge*

(e) The following named owners of lands do not consent to the opening of said proposed road:

All abutting owners consent to opening of road and make no claim for damages.

(f) The probable cost of such right-of-way where such consent is not had is estimated at:

(g) There are at present no roads whatever providing an outlet to market at Manhattan or elsewhere for the entire territory traversed by said proposed road. All of said territory is being settled up and reduced to a state of cultivation and the opening of this road is therefore a necessity to all the owners of said abutting lands, and to many more farmers occupying lands in the territory to the west of said proposed road.
