Petition for Road.

To The Hon. Board of County Commissioners, of Gallatin County, Mont.:

THE UNDERSIGNED, Your petitioners, Citizens of the United States, respectfully show and represent that they are residents of and freeholders in Road District No....., in the County of Gallatin, State of Montana, and taxable therein for road purposes, where the road, hereinafter petitioned for, is to be located, laid out and established, if this petition be granted; that the proposed road is a public convenience, and, we think, the public good requires it.

Your petitioners do respectfully ask and petition that a County Road.....40..... feet in width, to be a public highway, to be laid out, located and established.

And show

- (a) The general route of the proposed road.
- (b) Over what lands it is proposed to be established.
- (c) Who are the owners thereof.
- (d) Whether such of them as can be found, consent thereto.
- (e) Who of them do not consent.
- (f) The probable cost of such right-of-way where such consent is not had.
- (g) The necessity for and advantages of the proposed road as follows, to-wit:

- (a) From the N.W. corner of Sec. 1, T. 3, P.R. 5.E. due south one mile, thence due west one mile through center of Sec. 11, T. 3, P.R. 5.E.
- (b) Sec. 4, Sec. 1, S.E. 1/4 sec. 2, W. 1/2 sec. 12, N. 1/2 W. 1/2 sec. 11, all in T. 3, P.R. 5.E.
- (c) J. N. Ramsey owns all the land on East side of the change of Road, Wm Nash....., S.E. 1/4 sec. 2, T. 3, P.R. 5.E.
J. T. Widener and Henry N. Griffith and Helen K. Hodgeman in Sec. 11, T. 3, P.R. 5.E.
- (d)

- (g) The purpose is to straighten the road and put it on section lines, as it now is, it is crooked and runs mostly over Widener's land, in fact way into his; the same is the case with Hodgeman, who furnishes most of the road.
