# Petition for Road and Bridge

To The Hon. Board of County Commissioners, of Gallatin County, Mont.:

THE UNDERSIGNED, Your petitioners, Citizens of the United States, respectfully show and represent that they are residents and freeholders in Road District No. \_\_\_\_\_, in the County of Gallatin, State of Montana, and taxable therein for road purposes, when the road, hereinafter petitioned for, is to be located, laid out and established, if this petition be granted; that the proposed road is a public convenience, and, we think, the public good requires it.

Your petitioners do respectfully ask and petition that a County Road  Fifty  feet in width, to be a public highway, to be laid out, located and established.  and a Bridge to be built across the West Gallatin River   
And show

- (a) The general route of the proposed road.  Running East & West between Secs 24 34 and 26 & 35
- (b) Over what lands it is proposed to be established.  Two
- (c) Who are the owners thereof.  J A Aldaker Harry White & P C Nelson
- (d) Whether such of them as can be found, consent thereto.  Two
- (e) Who of them do not consent.  P C Nelson
- (f) The probable cost of such right-of-way where such consent is not had.  \$ 200

(g) The necessity for and advantages of the proposed road as follows, to-wit:

(a) Beginning at intersection of County Road, near North West corner of Sec 34 in Twp 2 S. R. & E. thence to run easterly along Section line between Sections 27 and 34, and between Sections 26 and 35 in Same Township and Range above mentioned and connect with the County Road running North and South through Sections 26 and 35 above designated and to build a Bridge of native material if same can be procured, for substantial construction, across the West Gallatin River at the most convenient point in proximity of the proposed route heretofore above described at the option of the Board of County Commissioners.

(b) (c) The lands above described are owned by the following named persons. Harry White in Sec 27 J Aldaker in Sec 34, P C Nelson in Sec 26 & McChas in Sec 35  
Proposed road to be three rods wide

The proposed Road and Bridge will afford an outlet to the Gallatin Valley Electric Railway and to Bozeman for the marketing of Corn and other produce from the farms of a great many people living West of the West Gallatin River and will afford access to said Railway for passenger and other traffic by such people, without traveling a remote distance for said service.

Also will afford an outlet for the people in event of washouts, swamp roads and snow blockades as have occurred at various times and especially during winter when traffic is almost entirely abandoned on account of drifting snow on the graded Road as at present established West of the Gallatin River.

The latter mentioned Road is the only outlet toward Bozeman and the principal marketing points of the Valley.
