Petition for Road

To The Hon. Board of County Commissioners, of Gallatin County, Mont.:

THE UNDERSIGNED, Your petitioners, Citizens of the United States, respectfully show and represent that they are residents and freeholders in Road District No. 2, in the County of Gallatin, State of Montana, and taxable therein for road purposes, when the road, hereinafter petitioned for, is to be located, laid out and established, if this petition be granted; that the proposed road is a public convenience, and, we think, the public good requires it.

Your petitioners do respectfully ask and petition that a County Road sixty feet in width, to be a public highway, to be laid out, located and established.

And show

- (a) The general route of the proposed road.
- (b) Over what lands it is proposed to be established.
- (c) Who are the owners thereof.
- (d) Whether such of them as can be found, consent thereto.
- (e) Who of them do not consent.
- (f) The probable cost of such right-of-way where such consent is not had.
- (g) The necessity for and advantages of the proposed road as follows, to-wit:

This petition is for a change in the road as now located and publicly used between Manhattan and Logan and the general route of the proposed change is described as follows; Starting near the North-west corner of South-east quarter of South-east quarter of Section 32, 2 n., 3 e. running parallel to Northern Pacific Railway right of way and distant 200 feet from the center thereof in a northwesterly direction to the intersection with North line of South-west quarter of said Section Thirty-two (32), thence due west along said line to center of section Thirty-one (31) where it rejoins and connects with the present old road to Logan.

The Manhattan Company is the owner of all land over which said proposed road runs and said company has consented thereto.

The necessity and advantages are as follows; This change in the route of the old road will shorten the distance between Manhattan and Logan by nearly $\frac{1}{2}$ mile; it will be an easier road to maintain as it cuts out one large bridge. It is also free of rocks and stones. The road from center of Sec. 32 to center of Sec 31 will be entirely constructed and fenced by your petitioners, free of expense to the County of Gallatin.
