Petition for Road

To The Hon. Board of County Commissioners, of Gallatin County, Mont.:

THE UNDERSIGNED, Your petitioners, Citizens of the United States, respectfully show and represent that they are residents and freeholders in Road District No. 6, in the County of Gallatin, State of Montana, and taxable therein for road purposes, when the road, hereinafter petitioned for, is to be located, laid out and established, if this petition be granted; that the proposed road is a public convenience, and, we think, the public good requires it.

Your petitioners do respectfully ask and petition that a County Road (40) Forty feet in width, to be a public highway, to be laid out, located and established.

And show

- (a) The general route of the proposed road.
- (b) Over what lands it is proposed to be established.
- (c) Who are the owners thereof.
- (d) Whether such of them as can be found, consent thereto.
- (e) Who of them do not consent.
- (f) The probable cost of such right-of-way where such consent is not had.
- (g) The necessity for and advantages of the proposed road as follows, to-wit:

- (1) Commencing where Houn Gulch Creek crosses County road on Sec. 7 Township 4 N. Range 5 East, Gallatin County Montana to follow up to head of said creek to top of Mountain at dividing line between Gallatin and Broadwater Counties. From starting point the general route will be North.
- (2) Over a small portion of Sec. 7 Township 4 N. Range 5 E Gallatin Co. Balance of distance all on Forest Reserve and some cleared land.
- (3) Owner of Section 7 Ole Horkson. Ole Horkson gives consent. Even though he objected the proposed road over his land has been traveled and used as a public road over nine years. No others to object.
- (4) No cost for right of way.
- (5) To open up a large section of country in Gallatin and Broadwater Counties to settlers. The distance from Milwaukee Ry being but ten miles from Stewart Basin while it is 25 miles to Northern Pacific Ry. Will bring a trade to Gallatin County that then goes to Broadwater County. Will open up a road over the mountains between Gallatin, Broadwater & Meagher Counties.

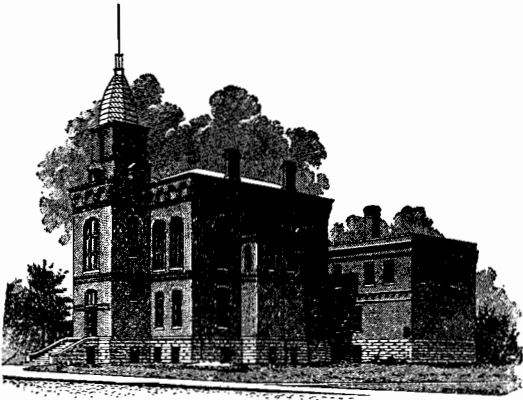

In pursuance of your order of Dec. 8, 1910, I have surveyed and platted road No. 351. I have platted this road in the plat book of roads, in the present ownership book, on the large road map and on the small road map. I find that this road passes through land owned by Ole Houghanson and by David Bagby both of whom I have mailed consent blanks. My survey commences on the east $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of sec. 12, township 4 north range 4 east, and closes on the east $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of sec. 15 township 5 north range 4 east. The last corner being a point on the County line.
