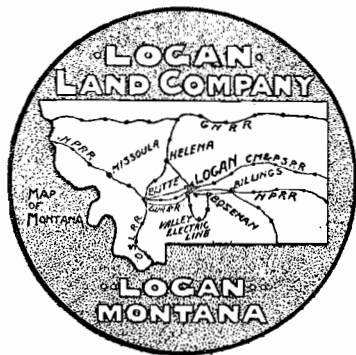
Sanity Commission
