To The Hon. Board of County Commissioners, of Gallatin County, Mont.:

THE UNDERSIGNED, Your petitioners, Citizens of the United States, respectfully show and represent that they are residents and freeholders in Road District No. 6, in the County of Gallatin, State of Montana, and taxable therein for road purposes, when the road, hereinafter petitioned for, is to be located, laid out and established, if this petition be granted; that the proposed road is a public convenience, and, we think, the public good requires it.

Your petitioners do respectfully ask and petition that a County Road 40 feet in width, to be a public highway, to be laid out, located and established.

And show

- (a) The general route of the proposed road.
- (b) Over what lands it is proposed to be established.
- (c) Who are the owners thereof.
- (d) Whether such of them as can be found, consent thereto.
- (e) Who of them do not consent.
- (f) The probable cost of such right-of-way where such consent is not had.
- (g) The necessity for and advantages of the proposed road as follows, to-wit:

Commencing at Main Street - Mandan, Crossing lots 16 & 17 to South line of Section Twelve (12) Thence East about one quarter mile to line between David Bagby & Ole Hougkman Thence follows foot line to line between Sections 17 & 18 Thence South to North West Corner of Section 18 - Thence South between Sections 17 & 18 one mile, Thence South about half mile between Sections 19 & 20. Thence South East about one half mile, Thence South East about one quarter mile to Albert Morgans home on Section Twenty - Township 4 - R. 5 - East Gallatin Co. Minn. Road goes through lands of J. P. Deeny - Ole Hougkman Arthur Martin - N. P. Ry, Co, Geo. Brunner & J. S. Morgan and Oliver DeYoung -

Land all donated by N. P. Ry and look for us protest from them as it goes on Section line

Necessary to have road to get in and out to our farms and get threshing Machine in -

Ole Hougkman donated land in consideration of County agreeing to lease road over his land and putting in stock pass -

- (g) The necessity for and advantages of the proposed road as follows, to-wit:

Starts at east end of Main Street at meadow pasture where bridge crosses Sixteen Mile Creek - follows C.M. & P.S. Ry 1/2 mile, then takes south easterly course till it strikes line between sections 7 & 18 - thence to N.E. corner of section 18. Thence south on section line between sections 7 & 18 one mile and south nearly 1/2 mile between sections 19 & 20 thence south east about 1/2 mile. Thence south 1/4 mile - to Albert Morgans house on section 20 - Township 4 - R. 5 East. Road goes through lands of J.P. Deemy - Ole Houghton, Arthur Martin - M.C. Ry. Co, Geo. Brainard - J.S. Morgan, Luan Pace - Oliver DeYoung - Albert Morgan - Owners are parties given above

The only one that will not consent is Ole Houghton the road goes over his land about one mile. The only kind of any value is about 1/2 acre of meadow land joining C.M. & P.S. right of way.

It is necessary to have said road as an outlet for Arthur Martin, Geo. Brainard, J.S. Morgan for section 19 Albert Morgan for homestead - Luan Pace, Miss Tracy Boardman, Ole Oliver DeYoung - These parties have no public road and now reach main roads only by going

over land of other parties by consent, and keeping  
up fences.

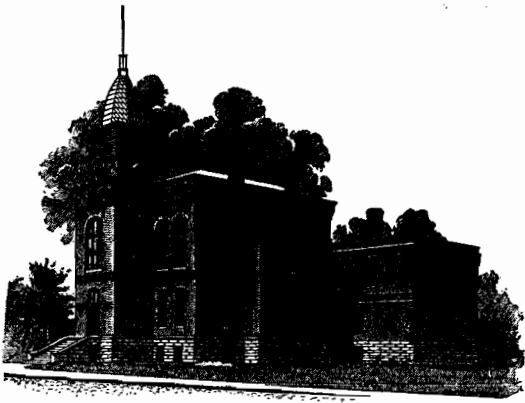
