Petition for Road

To The Hon. Board of County Commissioners, of Gallatin County, Mont.:

THE UNDERSIGNED, Your petitioners, Citizens of the United States, respectfully show and represent that they are residents and freeholders in Road District No. Two, in the County of Gallatin, State of Montana, and taxable therein for road purposes, when the road, hereinafter petitioned for, is to be located, laid out and established, if this petition be granted; that the proposed road is a public convenience, and, we think, the public good requires it.

Your petitioners do respectfully ask and petition that a County Road Sixty feet in width, to be a public highway, to be laid out, located and established.

And show

- (a) The general route of the proposed road.
- (b) Over what lands it is proposed to be established.
- (c) Who are the owners thereof.
- (d) Whether such of them as can be found, consent thereto.
- (e) Who of them do not consent.
- (f) The probable cost of such right-of-way where such consent is not had.
- (g) The necessity for and advantages of the proposed road as follows, to-wit:

(a) A New Road to begin on the center line running East and West of Section Twenty Three (23) One North, Tree East (1 N 3 E) and $\frac{1}{4}$ One quarter mile West of the quarter corner between section 23 and 24. (1 N 3 E) and on the West side of Meadow - View Cemetery. Thence in a South East direction to South corner of Cemetery. Thence in a North East direction back to quarter line on East side of Cemetery. Thence in an Easterly direction to quarter corner between sections (23) and (24). Thence in an Easterly direction through center of Sec. 24 to quarter corner on East side and connecting with the Heube Road.

(b) Over the East $\frac{1}{2}$ of the South East quarter and the East $\frac{1}{2}$ of the North East quarter of (23) and through and over the center line of Sec 24. (1 N, 3 E)

(c) Walter White. Benje Berglund co. S. M. Lennan Trustee. Mrs. Mabel Curtis. W. M. Curtis and Robert M. Clelen.

(d) I hereby agree to give free of charge Thirty feet of my Land adjoining the above proposed road for that purpose. Also move back and put in the necessary new fencing to enclose my Land W. W. Curtis
I hereby agree to sell to the county 30 feet of my Land for the above proposed Road at Fifty Dollars per acre. And will move back my $\frac{1}{4}$ mile fence to new line, and build the $\frac{1}{4}$ mile of new fence, the county to furnish four black barbe wires and enough white cedar posts to build the quarter mile. We will give a strip of land 30 feet wide on the north line of SW 1/4 Sec 24 T. 1 N. R. 3 E. for said road + move our fence back to this line free of expense to said County of Gallatin. Signed.

I will give a strip of land, 30ft wide, on the south side of the NE 1/4 of Sec. 23, 1N, 3E, for the above proposed road, free of charge; Provided the county will move the fence back the 30ft and bare the expense of the same.

I will take \$50.00 per acre for 30 feet of land for proposed Road and the County to furnish material and do the Fencing.

Mrs. C. D. Burts

I will give a strip of land, 30 feet wide on my land, subject to location made by the road viewers and will change fence at my own expense.

(c) The above Road would give the people in and around Central Park and those located on the Hebe Road a direct route to the Meadow-View Cemetery. Also give a cross Road about half way between Manhattan and the Base line which is a distance of about 4 1/2 miles without a cross Road.
