Petition for Road

To The Hon. Board of County Commissioners, of Gallatin County, Mont.:

THE UNDERSIGNED, Your petitioners, Citizens of the United States, respectfully show and represent that they are residents and freeholders in Road District No. _____, in the County of Gallatin, State of Montana, and taxable therein for road purposes, when the road, hereinafter petitioned for, is to be located, laid out and established, if this petition be granted; that the proposed road is a public convenience, and, we think, the public good requires it.

Your petitioners do respectfully ask and petition that a County Road 60 feet in width, to be a public highway, to be laid out, located and established.

And show

(a) The general route of the proposed road.

(b) Over what lands it is proposed to be established.

(c) Who are the owners thereof.

(d) Whether such of them as can be found, consent thereto.

(e) Who of them do not consent.

(f) The probable cost of such right-of-way where such consent is not had.

(g) The necessity for and advantages of the proposed road as follows, to-wit:

A direct route for a large number of people living on the north side of the Jefferson River to come to town and a shorter route for those people to Forkmont.

Route of proposed road commencing at the north side of Milwaukee Right of way at Willow Creek Station and running in a westerly direction through Section 18 T1 N R 1 E on the half section line between Malisse Green & A. J. Woodward to the Jefferson River a distance of about one mile to connect with a main line road proposed by Jefferson County people in said petition for the removal of the Jefferson River Bridge known as the Willow Creek Bridge to be placed at the river crossing where this road should cross so that a new bridge if deemed best be placed at said crossing.

REMONSTRANCE PETITION AGAINST MOVING WILLOW CREEK BRIDGE.

To The Honorable Board of County Commissioners of Jefferson County, Montana, and the Honorable Board of County Commissioners of Gallatin County, Montana:

We, the undersigned, residents of Jefferson and Gallatin Counties, hereby protest and remonstrate against the proposed removal of that certain bridge commonly known as the Willow Creek Bridge, said bridge crossing the Jefferson River at a point in Section 26; Twp. 1 North; Range 1 West; M.P.M. uniting the Counties of Gallatin and Jefferson, the said bridge being jointly constructed by said two counties, and hereby represent to the Honorable Boards of the two respective counties, that said removal would be unjust, impracticable and injurious to the people of both counties, for the following reasons: 1. For the reason that the present location of the bridge is the most desirable that can be obtained as it is immune from any damage or danger from high water or any change by the river bed. 2. That any change of location as proposed by the petitioners for the removal of said bridge would incur a great expenses to both counties by placing the bridge in a position where it would require great expense in grading and expose it at all times to danger from high-water and destruction by changes in the river bed. That it would be a great injustice to the people that contributed in labor and money to the construction of the bridge at its present location and as regards the general public, the proposed change in the location of the bridge would accomplish no practical or beneficial purpose whatever.
